## JESUITS' SUPERIOR



Very Rev. Vladimir Ledochowski

**Father Ledochowski,  
Jesuit General, Dies**

VATICAN CITY.—The Very Rev. Vladimir Ledochowski, General of the Society of Jesus for 27 years, died at the Jesuit Mother house on Dec. 13.

Father Ledochowski, the distinguished leader of the Jesuit Order who was 76 years old, was fortified by the Last Rites of the Church and by a special blessing of His Holiness Pope Pius XII when death came.

He was the twenty-sixth General of the Jesuits and no Superior in the four centuries of the Society's history ever faced more serious international conditions.

Elected General of the Society on Feb. 11, 1911, Father Ledochowski took office in the first year of the First World War and after more than a quarter of a century in office witnessed the nations plunged into the Second World War.

On the occasion of Father Ledochowski's golden jubilee as a Jesuit and his silver jubilee as the General of the Society the Pope sent him an impressive congratulatory letter. The Holy Father spoke not only of the marvelous accomplishments of Father Ledochowski as a guide and exemplar of the Society but with affectionate gratitude referred to his signal offices for the common good of the whole Church.

VATICAN CITY. An envelope containing the name of a Vicar General selected by the Very Rev. Vladimir Ledochowski, General of the Society of Jesus, who died Dec. 13, was opened at the Jesuit Generalate in Rome at 4 P.M. Dec. 13 in the presence of the entire Community of the Generalate.

The document named the Rev. Alessio Ambrogio Magni to govern the Society until the election of a new General, which will probably be after the war owing to the difficulty of convoking a General Chapter.

**Make Vow To Complete  
Naples Cathedral**

VATICAN CITY. A vow to complete the facade and side towers of the Naples Cathedral that the city may be spared from grave calamity was made to the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Januarius in a ceremony in which His Eminence Alessio Cardino, Ascalisi, Archbishop of Naples, led a great multitude of the Neapolitan faithful.

The ceremony took place in the Naples Cathedral, on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception.

**Archbishop Mooney Named  
To Board of Red Cross**

WASHINGTON.—The Most Rev. Edward Mooney, Archbishop of Detroit and Chairman of the Administrative Board of the National Catholic Welfare Conference, has been appointed a member of the Board of Incorporators of the American Red Cross.

Announcement of the appointment was made at the agency's annual meeting here this week, at which Norman H. Davis, who was reappointed Chairman, reported that the Red Cross had expended \$62,000,000 in foreign war relief in the first year of the war.




