Parents of the Cubs are not only invited, but urged to be present on this occasion.

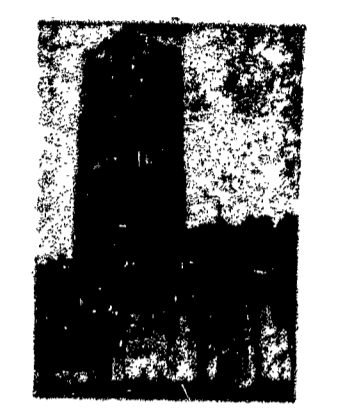

## Doctor Cormier Rites Held

Funeral services for Dr. J. Arthur Cormier, highly respected physician and Catholic layman, were held Tuesday, Dec. 15 at the home, 50 Ridge Road East and at St. Joseph's Church where Solemn Requiem Mass was offered.

Doctor Cormier who was 81 years of age died Dec. 11, 1942 in St. Mary's hospital after an illness of five days.

Born in L'Assomption, Quebec, Canada, Dr. Cormier received his medical degree from Laval University, Montreal in 1882. Coming to Rochester the following year he had been in active practice until stricken ill. He served as physician at old St. Joseph's Orphan Asylum for more than 50 years.

Bearers were Wendell Bayer, John Schaefer, Emil Vogel, Raymond Tierney, Anthony Link and Jacob Bertram. His fellow physicians were honorary bearers including Doctors Leo F. Simpson, Joseph Mayer, Harry Hummel, Frank Maynard, James David and B. J. Duffy.

He was an honorary life member of Rochester Council, Knights of Columbus, the Medical Society of the County of Monroe and the American Medical Society.

## FUNERAL RITES CONDUCTED FOR JEROME KOESTERER

Funeral services were held on Thursday morning, Dec. 17, at Our Lady of Victory Church for Jerome Koesterer, 84, violinist and cigar maker and a former employee of the Catholic Courier and Journal. Mr. Koesterer worked in the circulation department of the paper until 1933 and was widely known and esteemed by readers of the paper.

He is survived by one son, Elmer J. Koesterer, three daughters, Sister M. Brigitta of the Order of the Sisters of Notre Dame, Mrs. Edward Lux and Mrs. Edward Baker, six grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.
