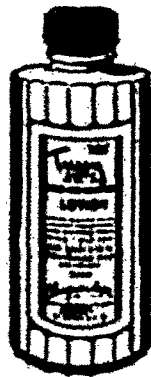

Rabun Gap-Hacchoos

On Highway No. 21, inside the border of Georgia but very near the North Carolina side, is a Junior College giving two years of agricultural training. The school is near a mountain (Hacchoos Falls) with an elevation of 4,700 feet. It is in Rabun County; Clayton is the county seat.

There is a 1,000-acre school farm, located at the head of the Little Tennessee River. Red brick buildings are set upon a hill. Two hundred acres are used for a boarding school for young men and women, paying for their education by farming and domestic work.

The outer circle of 1,000 acres is a farm settlement where whole families receive both agricultural instruction and a living in return for their labor. Fourteen families, in rotating groups, with 50 acres of land, a model six-room cottage, a barn and outhouse, farm the land under approved methods of agriculture. The farm is operated on a share-crop basis, and the farmers assist in marketing the produce, purchasing the supplies and keeping accounts.

Adjacent to the boarding school farm is the day school where vocational education is extended to the children of the surrounding district. This was the original school, begun in 1920 by the consolidation of two country schools. The institution is supported by appropriations of state and Federal funds and by private donations.

The school was founded under the auspices of the Presbyterian Church.
