Crusade By Holy Name
Youth To Curb
Delinquency, Urged

LAWRENCE, Wis.—Calling for a crusade by Holy Name Society boys to beat back a general resurgence of juvenile delinquency, the Most Rev. Alexander J. McGivney, Bishop of La Crosse reminds in a Pastoral Letter that "there are two fronts in this war for liberty and against enslavement, the battle front and the home front, and both must be maintained."

Bishop McGivney says reports from many sources indicate the rise in juvenile delinquency and a sharp increase in crime committed by youths under 20. He blames this in a large measure on the "present disturbed condition of our country."

"Indeed youth whether boys or girls, can quickly and easily rise to splendid heights of interest and enthusiasm even sacrifice in an appealing cause when given encouragement and proper direction," the Pastor says. "The cause in this instance is sure to be an appealing one."

"What nobler cause could there be than to practice and propagate the Christian life, diffusing it among others by prayer, example, suggestion and kindly advice, especially encouraging respect for parents and the observance of law."

"A crusade like that at this time would assist in keeping the home front intact and unbroken just as our boys in faraway places are holding and extending the battle front."

"This does not require any new organization, it can be done wholly within the Holy Name Society

to which all boys of high school age belong or should belong and to those boys the crusade should be limited. It would, however, be helpful to have each boy seated together at Holy Name Communions and monthly meetings so that they could be directly appealed to, stimulated and encouraged."
