Credibility of Dogma Shown in New Theology Book By Dr. Fenton

A book demonstrating the credibility of Catholic dogma, entitled "We Stand With Christ," has been written by the Rev. Joseph Clifford Fenton, S.T.D., former professor of theology at St. Bernard's Seminary, here, from 1935 to 1938, now assistant professor of dogmatic theology at the Catholic University of America, Washington, D. C.

Publication of the book is announced by Bruce Publishing Co., Milwaukee. Dr. Fenton's book is the first English work in apologetics to utilize the most recent methodological and archaeological findings.

Dr. Fenton came to St. Bernard's seminary after serving for two years as professor of philosophy at St. Ambrose college in Davenport, Iowa. He holds a doctorate in sacred theology from the Institutum Angelicum in Rome. Father Fenton left Rochester in 1938 to take up his present position as assistant professor of dogmatic theology at the Catholic University of America.

Through writing on the subject, Dr. Fenton is establishing a reputation in this country as one of the leading American authorities on theology. Two earlier books, "The Theology of Prayer," and "The Concept of Sacred Theology," received a fine reception from the American public.

In outlining the purpose of his latest book, Dr. Fenton states: "There is a certain body of teaching which Catholics believe. We Stand With Christ sets forth the claims which the Church makes for this teaching, analyzing Catholic dogma as a message from God to man through Jesus of Nazareth. The Catholic Church asserts that there is an evident seal of Divine authority attached to this teaching. We Stand With Christ indicates this Divine Signature. The book shows the manifest credibility of Catholic dogma and points out the good which this teaching can and must do in America."

In presenting the claims of Jesus, Dr. Fenton shows the proofs Christ offered in support of His claims and how they can be demonstrated. The author ventures to cite texts of pertinent documents more extensively than is usual in a work of this type as direct evidence. Above all similar works, this one is organized towards a clear and certain demonstration that Catholic dogma is rationally acceptable. For scriptural citations Dr. Fenton uses the Confraternity revision of the Douay version.

Mexico Altar Visited By Gen. Sikorski Gift Of Convert Polish Jew

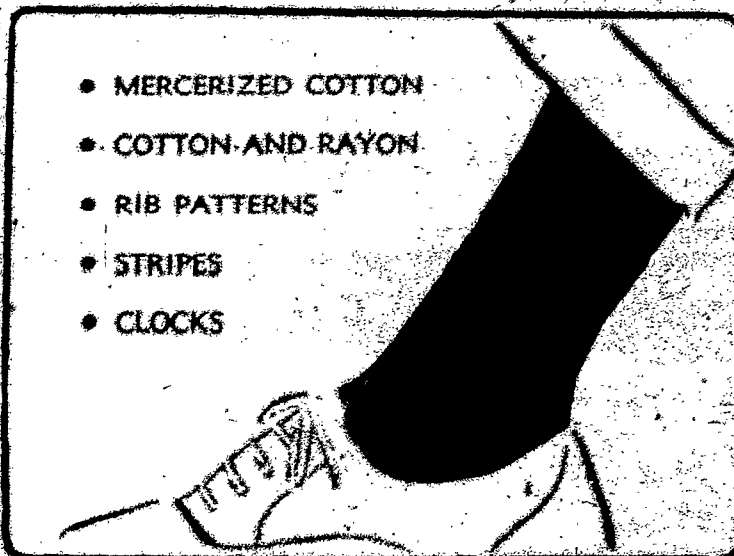
