

# Evangelization of Russia Hopeful Believes Writer of Faith of People

ISBON.—An article published originally in the Orthodox magazine *Pravo-Slavnyas* Bessarabia, and signed by Prof. has attracted considerable attention because of the optimistic attitude regarding the future evangelization of Russia. The author, who says his deductions are based on personal contact with Soviet citizens and Russian prisoners of war in Germany, believes that Bolshevism has never succeeded in effecting the Russian national sentiment which is being stamped with orthodox conceptions of the world; and that new Russia will be built only by the spirit of orthodoxy—an inalienable presupposition of civilization and the Russian State. As to the current attitude of the Russian people towards religion, Prof. divides the population into three principal groups of different numerical importance. Into the first group, those who have not lost the faith of their fathers, he puts the great mass of the people, particularly peasants. Anti-religious propaganda, he contends, has never succeeded in penetrating the masses of the Russian national. The only thing that has been lost, he writes, "is a naive primitive faith in religious forces, and the conventional expression of religious sentiment which, too often, is confused with piety.
