#### Mission Cut Off By Japs, Priest Fears For Bishop's Safety

CALCUTTA, India.—Cut off from his mission headquarters by the Japanese invasion of the Mandalay area for nearly a year, the Rev. P. Bilvet, here on an append for Catholic literature, said he still had been unable to learn the whereabouts of his Bishop, the Most Rev. Albert Peter Feliere, Vicar Apostolic of Mandalay, and his fellow clergymen.
