New York Archbishop's Attack On Stage Immorality Landed By Chilean Daily Paper

SANTIAGO, (NC)—In the United States, "a free, enlightened and truly civilized country," it is recognized that "liberty is not license and cannot serve as a shield for public immorality," the Chilean *El Mundo* newspaper of this Capital, says in an editorial on the commission of an immoral play made by the Most Rev. Francis J. Brennan, Archbishop of New York, "with the backing of the civil authorities."

"The duty to watch over public morality, making use of the right of censorship conferred by the laws, is more imperative for those citizens who, invested with a high mission, as priests are, cannot remain indifferent in the face of luxury in customs, which is a constant threat to the good order of human society," the editorial asserts. It adds that neither should the fulfillment of this duty "be the object of suspicious hatreds or of badly intentioned campaigns leading to the loss of prestige."

"These assumptions of ours," explains *El Mundo*, "have been confirmed recently and opportunely by something that has occurred in the United States."

The daily then cites the protest "spoken with all vigor from the pulpit" by the Archbishop of New York "against the wave of immorality which is developing in that city," and especially against the play entitled "Wine, Women and Song."

"And it occurred to no one to silence the voice of the great Prelate," added the Chilean daily. "None of the authorities was alarmed; no Cabinet member called the Archbishop in haste to

ask him for the part of the importance of religion, to disseminate his campaign. On the contrary, all the authorities from the District Attorney to the Mayor, supported the attitude of the Catholic who, together with their position, undertake a true crusade against immorality."

After describing briefly the important judgment against the producers of the play, the editorial concludes: "Public opinion, Catholic and non-Catholic, supported actively this campaign, started from the pulpit by a Catholic Archbishop and continued by the civil authorities. Liberty of the theater was not alleged nor liberty of the right of criticism; for in that country, free, enlightened and truly civilized, it is recognized that liberty is not license and cannot serve as a shield for public immorality, to the scandal and the corruption of morals. It is also recognized that the worthy use of liberty ought not to be restrained, but stimulated; and that there is no nobler practice than its exercise it from the pulpit, or from any other tribunal, to protect society, and especially the young boys and girls, against the wave of corruption that threatens to invade the world."

CATHOLIC WOMEN URGED TO 'GIVE AND CARRY' IN SOLDIER BOOK DRIVE

NEW YORK CITY.—To overcome difficulties occasioned by the gasoline and tire rationing, Catholic women's organizations participating in the current 1943 Victory Book Campaign have been asking individual members to carry books donated to local collection centers or to arrange group transportation of books.

The "give and carry" move was detailed in letters sent out to members by the International Federation of Catholic Alumnae, which with the National Council of Catholic Women, is cooperating with the Red Cross, USO and the American Library Association, the sponsoring groups, in the campaign. John F. Hickey, of this city, a member of the executive committee of the National Catholic Community Service, is treasurer of the campaign.

JAIL SENTENCES IMPOSED IN OBSCENITY CAMPAIGN

CHICAGO.—A campaign by the office of the State's Attorney here against persons engaged in the distribution and sale of obscene literature is in progress. Four men were convicted and sentenced to the maximum penalty of six months in jail by Judge Joseph Hermes in recent weeks, while additional defendants were convicted and sentenced in the court of Judge Frank H. Dougherty. The prosecutions were handled by Francis T. McCurtis, of the State Attorney's staff.
