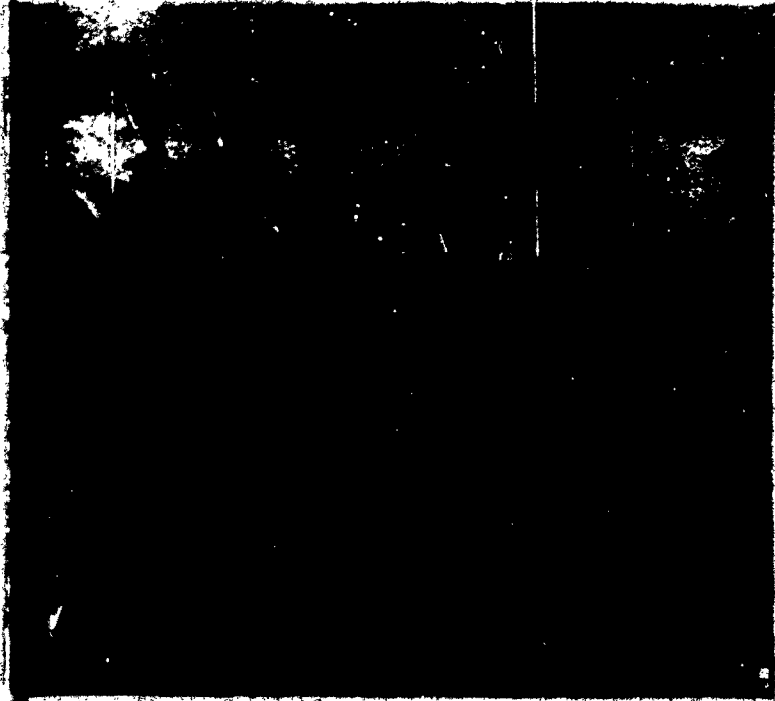


# Avers Soviet Volume Belies Russia's Religious Situation

# Youth Delinquency Rise Causes National Interest

WASHINGTON—Juvenile delinquency is decidedly on the increase. This rise in crime forces observers to wonder if those on the "home front" aren't leaving a weak sector of their line dangerously unguarded.

The need for drafting fathers may decline and the practice may have to be abandoned, although some legislators believe it should be avoided as long as possible, so they feel it is disruptive of family life.

There is still just as much, and just as widespread, opposition to the employment of mothers in war work, unless and until every other source of employment has been exhausted.

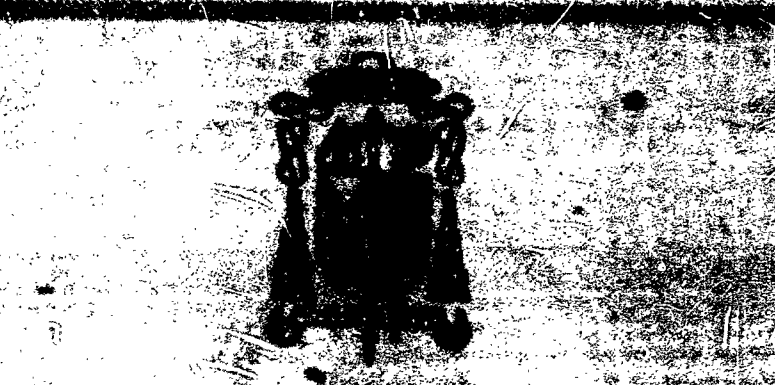
