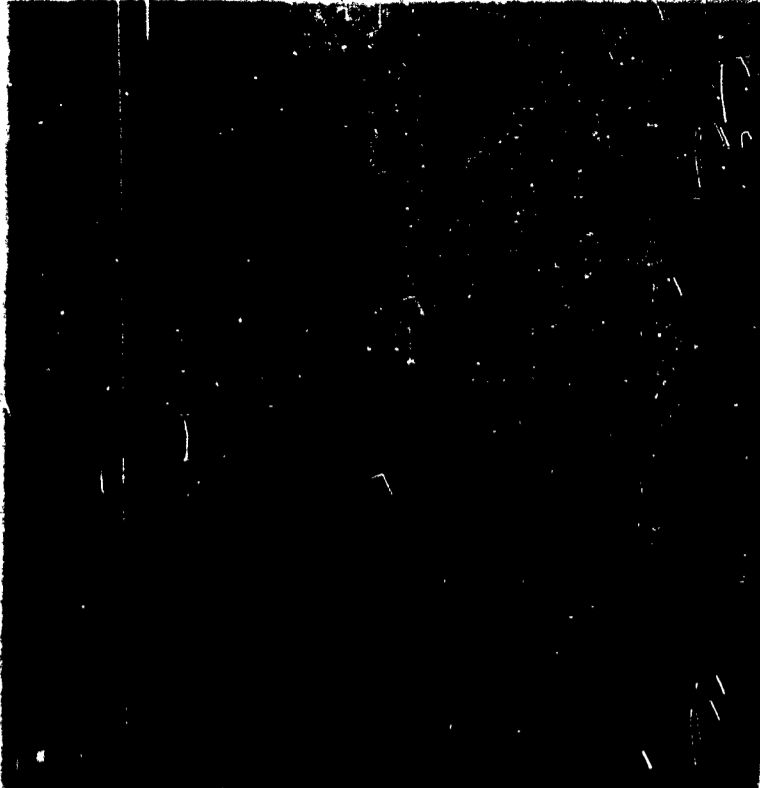

Highlighting the program Captain Eugene L. Grant, U.S. Senior Captain of the Naval Training Station at Annapolis, will strike a realistic chord with his message. On the speaker's platform also will be Mayor Samuel Dickler, Raymond Hall and Warren Parks of the local and state Stamp Committee. His Excellency, Bishop Kearney, will have a definite message of commendation to all participating schools. According to Rev. John M. Duffy, reports of Stamp sales and other war activities will be given as a part of the program to represent school representatives with the schools war program. The invitations to attend the Rally have been accepted by the out-of-town schools of the Diocese. Admission is to ticket only.

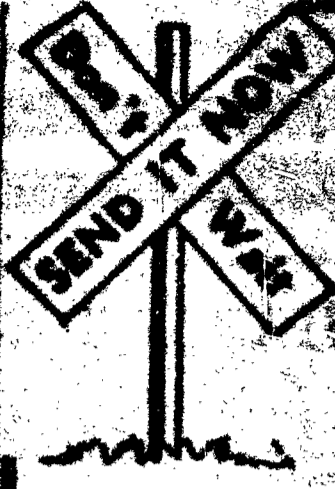
### Dr. Max Jordan Will Direct NBC Programs
