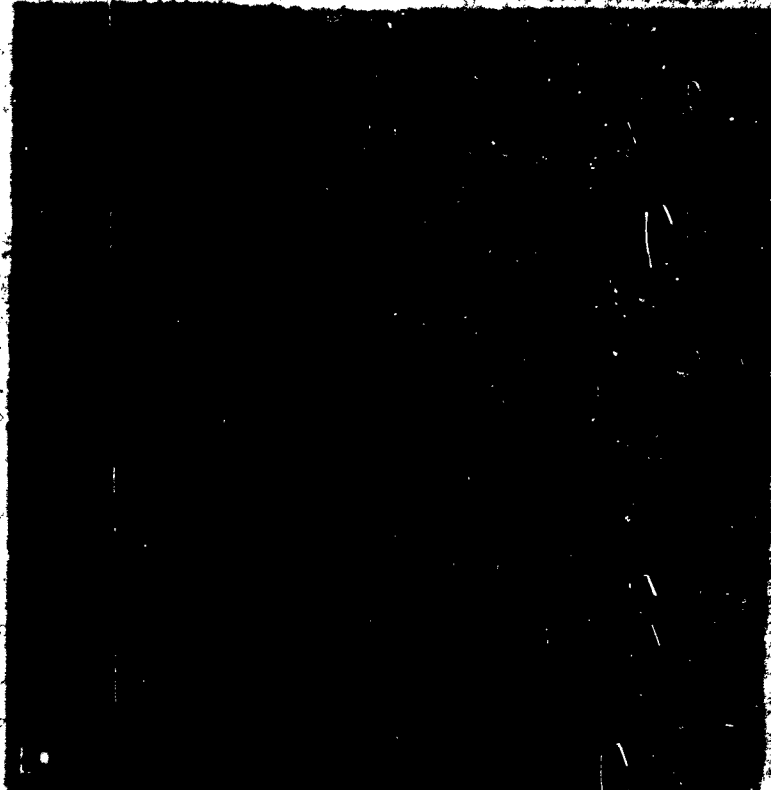

Prizes and medals will be awarded by Aquinas Head. Among the winners in their program are the St. Mary's and March of the Feet; My Hero—General March—M.M.R. and All Out for America. Under the chairmanship of Robert Stone, Aquinas will handle the selling for the rally. The grand finale will be a street by a military band, "Victory in Action," presented by 20 students of Our Lady of Mercy High School. Sophie Bennett will portray the part of Our Lady of Victory while Shirley Redwick is the narrator. As the scene unfolds, the audience will join in the singing of the National Anthem.

Highlighting the program Chaplain Joseph C. Diener, U.S.N.C., former Chaplain of the United States Marine Corps at St. Paul, will deliver a rousing address with his message. On the speaker's platform, also will be Mayor Samuel E. Dolner, Episcopal Bishop and Warren Parks of the local and state Stamps Committee. His Excellency, Bishop Kearney, will have a definite message of commendation to all participating schools. Addressing to Rev. John M. Daffy, Rector of Stoney sales and other war activities will be given as a part of the program to acquaint about Rochester with the school war program. The invitations to attend the Rally have been accepted by the out-of-town schools of the diocese. Admission is by ticket only.

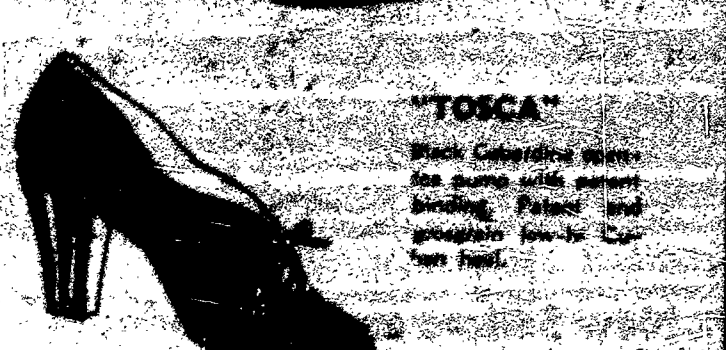
