ST. LOUIS.—The special theme of the forthcoming Summer School of Catholic Action, to be held in five centers, will be: "Our personal part in the Christ-like world of the future, a world marked by the practice of the social spirit . . . a genuine human and fraternal

Christian unity." It is announced by the Queen's Work here, national secretary, the sponsoring organization. The announcement stressed that this year's program, regarded as the most important in the 12 years of the enterprise, because of world

conditions, would be "intensely fundamental," with objectives being the presentation of the basic ideals, laid down by Christ and explained by the Pope, on which "a decent world can be built after victory: the working out of a program by which you individually can help rebuild the world in your immediate neighborhood, in the district, province, in the people and in the nation."

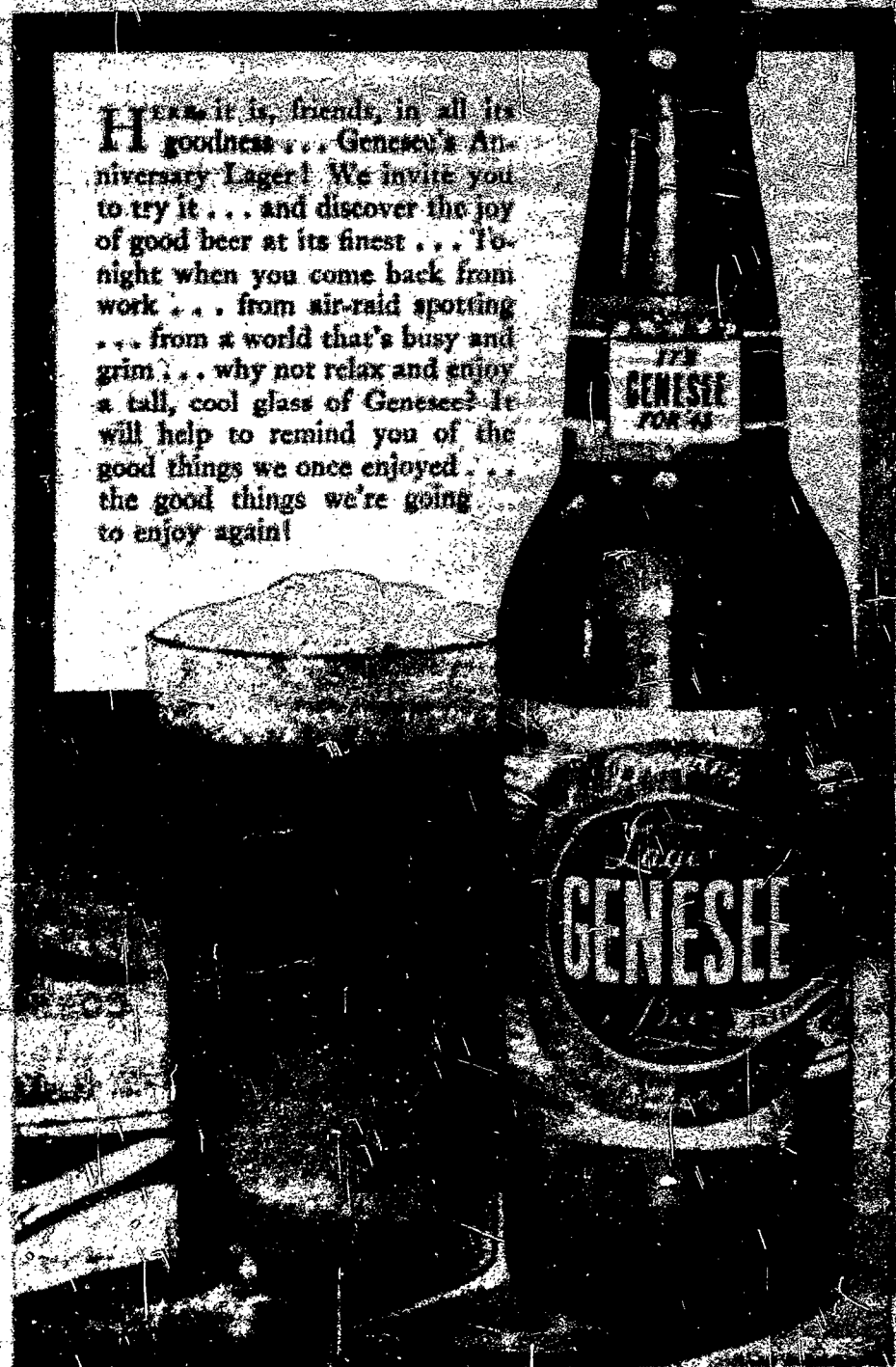
