**WAR MEDICINE MEETING SET BY N. Y. STATE DOCTORS**

**BUFFALO.**—Plans are complete for a War-Medicine meeting of the state's physicians here May 3-6. According to Dr. Carlton E. Wertz, chairman of the sub-committee on arrangements, thousands of doctors will leave their busy duties to attend and learn the latest developments of science, so that when they return home they will be better able to protect their local communities. It will be the one hundred thirty-seventh annual meeting of the Medical Society of the State of New York. Among important features are to be: recent advances in industrial medicine for the protection of workers; the latest methods of using blood plasma in cases of shock. The value of plasma in the injuries due to catastrophic or sabotage has been increased by recent experience in the war, and all physicians should understand these new developments. There will be demonstrations of the effects of war gas, a new subject to most physicians. Also new to American physicians is the recognition and treatment of tropical diseases. Many soldiers and sailors will return after the war with these ailments which have been heretofore unknown to medicine in this country.
