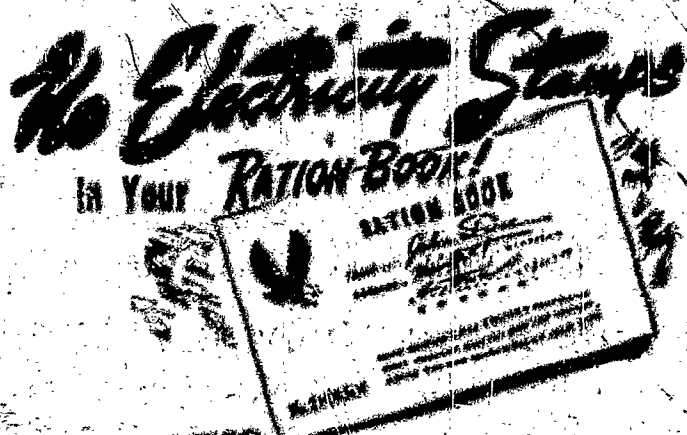

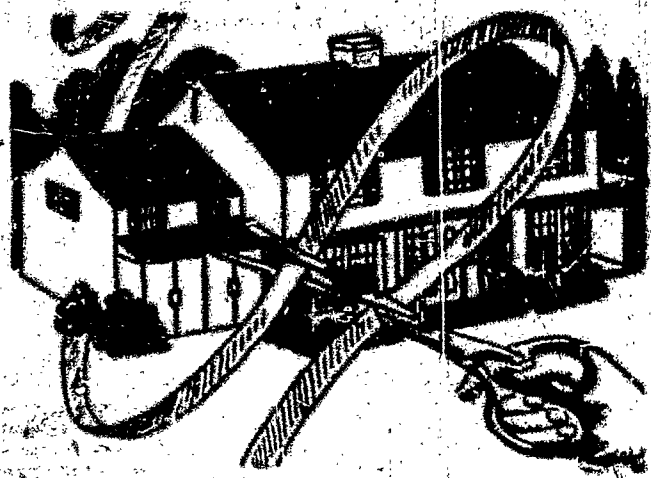

All of us would offend others less often, cause less mischief and spare ourselves considerable misery if we stopped to think before we blurted out a lot of the things we say.

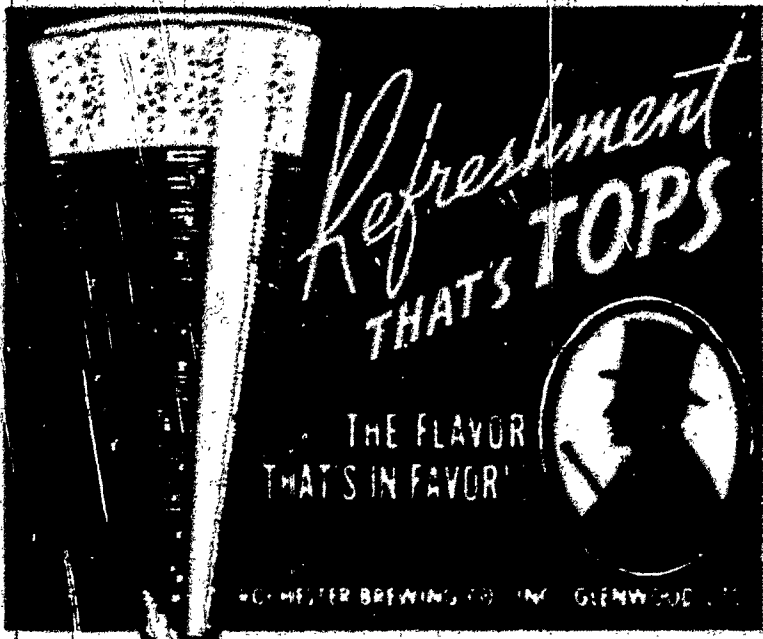
