John Coveney

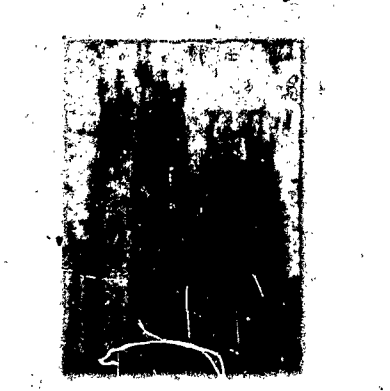

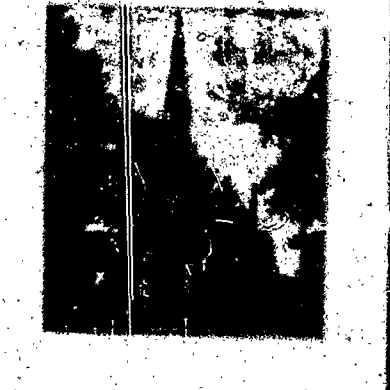
