Finds English Seek
Non-Political 'Family
Union' With U. S.

NEW YORK (NCW)—A non-political "family union" of "decent men who center their lives on football, Wordsworth, roast beef, the Bill of Rights" is the Englishman's vision of "the brave new world" and a vision with which the American citizen, in particular, should be familiar, the Very Rev. Robert L. Gannon, S.J., president of Fordham University declared at the Fordham University Alumni Association Communion breakfast at the Hotel Waldorf Astoria.

Father Gannon arrived here from England Friday night after having been in Great Britain since the beginning of Lent to preach a course of sermons at Westminster Cathedral.

"Everywhere in England there is a profound conviction that from now on the destinies of England and the United States are definitely joined," Father Gannon said. "In all classes of society I found that nobody had any political interest. It was not a question of a political union. They want no political union but the development of a genuine friendship that is elastic and makes for just understandings in any discussion that may come, a friendship so that we will trust one another no matter what may arise. 'Group of Decent Men'."

"They want no union between a guileless Democracy and a big gully empire spreading its tentacles over the earth. What they want is a group of decent men who center their lives on roast beef, football, Wordsworth and the Bill of Rights, and similar groups in Canada, Australia and New Zealand. England is looking this way."

Father Gannon, who visited England 17 years ago, said he was impressed by the fact that the ignorance of America and Americans which he observed at that time has given way to widespread knowledge of all aspects of America, its geography as well as its history.

"Want American Friends?" He said he noticed in the man in the street a determination to make all "visiting Americans, especially soldiers, 'friends of the Empire.'"

The principal effect of the war in England according to Father Gannon has been "a great consciousness of the other half," an increase in tolerance and understanding and a new respect between Catholic and Protestant.

"The Catholics and Protestant of England never got along as well as they do now," he said. "Arthur Cardinal Hinsley was responsible for this in a large part. He himself was a great patriot, a great soldier and his funeral was an occasion for national sorrow. Cardinal Hinsley's friendship with the Archbishop of Canterbury is symbolic of war-time England."
