The school was dedicated on Sept. 7, 1931, and was first opened for classes on Monday morning, Sept. 11, that year. The school was built during the period that the Rev. Andrew E. Green, D.D., was pastor of St. Patrick's parish and cost in the neighborhood of \$80,000. At that time it relieved the village of Mt. Morris of building a \$10,000 annex to the public school.

LAWN FESTIVAL

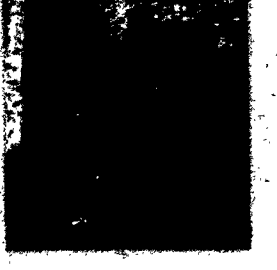
