### Dansville Graduates To Hear Fr. Devireaux

MR. MORRIS—On Friday evening, June 18, in St. Patrick's School auditorium the 31st annual commencement exercises and graduation will be held. The school was dedicated on Sept. 7, 1911, and was first opened for classes on Monday morning, Sept. 11, that year. The school was built during the period that the Rev. Andrew E. Green, D.D., was pastor of St. Patrick's parish and cost in the neighborhood of \$80,000. At that time it relieved the village of Mt. Morris of building a \$10,000 annex to the public school.

The program, this year, will start at 8 o'clock with the students of the school presenting an enjoyable entertainment under the direction of the Sisters of St. Joseph. Following the entertainment will be the graduating exercises with the Rev. William A. Rafferty, pastor of the parish, presenting the diplomas and annual awards. The Rev. William Devireaux of Nunda will deliver the address to the graduates concluding the program.

### EVIDENCE GUILD METHOD FOLLOWED IN PERU CRUSADE

LIMA—(U. C.)—A crusade in defense of Catholic truth, initiated by a group of Catholic women here and having the approbation and blessing of His Excellency the Most Rev. Fernando Cento, Espal Nuncio to Peru, and the Most Rev. Pedro Pascual Farfan, Archbishop of Lima, is following the Evidence Guild Method.

The Crusade has already opened three "fronts" of religious instruction: One group meets at the old militia parade-ground, Parque de la Reserva, on Sunday afternoons; another in the Victoria section on Wednesday at 8 P. M., and the third in the new Ascona residential section on Sundays, Tuesdays and Thursdays at 8 P. M. The last is a quarter in which Protestant propagandizing has been very intense.

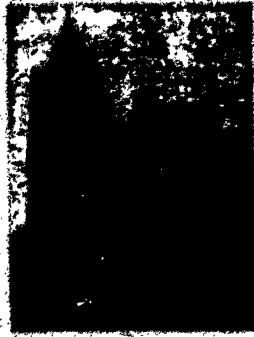
## Graduation Set At Mercy High
