K. of C. Fund Provides
Five Chaplains' Kits

Five Mass Kits for Chaplains in the armed forces will be purchased with the funds collected by Rochester Council, Knights of Columbus. This information came from Judge Martin J. Fay of Tonawanda, Chairman of the State War Activities Committee, this week to Grand Knight Thomas H. O'Connor.
The Chaplains' Aid Fund Campaign was conducted in Rochester Council under the chairmanship of Frank M. Beaucaire. All funds collected in the state (totaling \$11,500) were presented to His Excellency, Bishop Kearney, State Chaplain, at the convention in Albany. Joseph P. Flynn was diocesan chairman of the campaign.
At the State Dinner, Bishop Kearney turned the funds over to Bishop John F. O'Hara, C.S.C., Military Delegate of the Armed Forces for use by the Chaplains' Aid Association. As each Mass Kit costs \$150, the Rochester contributions of \$750 purchased five complete outfits for Chaplains to celebrate the Holy Mass on the field or aboard ship.
