

Ration Wine For Mass In Germany

FRIBOURG, Switzerland.—(AP)—Wine sold in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass in Germany now is being rationed, according to a report received by KIFA, Catholic International Press Agency.

The report stated that wine can be requested for only a six-month period and is not rationed in a general but in a specific church. The rationing measures prevent a priest, transferred to another parish or to another diocese, from taking a supply of wine with him from his church. The application for wine, the report stated, must include the names of all priests in the parish, together with a statement of the supply on hand.
