the Bishop will be Lieut. John S. Kuhn. The Deacons of Honor are Lieut. (2d) Nicasius F. Gralinski and Lieut. (3d) Roger J. Considine. O.F.M. Lieut. (2d) Arthur P. Ryan, C.S.C., and Lieut. (3d) William Moher are Deacons and Subdeacons of the Mass. Serving as Masters of Ceremonies are Lieut. Eugene B. LeGault and the Rev. Lawrence H. Casey, Secretary to the Bishop. The minor servers and servers at the Mass will be enlisted men from the station.

The entire program has attracted national interest. Chaplain Father LeGault has announced. Many of the newest cameramen, including those from MGM, Paramount, Universal, Pathé and the March of Time—will be on hand to photograph the ceremonies. Likewise all the news gathering agencies will be present to give press news coverage.

This military field Mass will be celebrated on F Unit drill field, one of the five recruit training drill fields at the station. The drill field slopes gradually toward the shore of Seneca Lake, offering an exceptionally aromatic setting for the occasion. It is flanked on four sides by barracks, drill hall, mess hall and other buildings comprising the training unit.

"Both in its religious and patriotic aspects," Father LeGault says, "the affair is expected to prove of a highly impressive nature." The entire crowd will join in singing "The Star Spangled Banner" at the conclusion of the Mass. The procession led by the Crossbearer, flanked by the American Flag and the Standard of Sampson and accompanied by a Color Guard, under the command of Captain Harry A. Reid and Captain Joseph Colman, Executive Officer, will assist Bishop Kearney from the temporary field altar to a nearby willow.


