MONTGOMERY, Ala. — The Alabama State Senate has voted an indefinite postponement of a bill which would provide for the legalization of sterilizing the feeble-minded and persons who suffer from certain hereditary forms of insanity.

The action was taken following a brief debate between the sponsor of the measure, Senator Bruce Henderson, of Wilcox, and Senator Vincent Kilborn of Mobile, on the necessity for the sterilization.
