ST. BONIFACE PARISH

Organizations in Parish

Attention of our parishioners is called to the many advantages offered by the organizations which have existed for many years in this parish. The various societies may be classed as religious, social or benevolent. Every parishioner should be affiliated with one or more of these church societies.

The **Nearly Society** is open to all, and the principal aim is to encourage the devotion of the Holy Rosary, the praying of same for departed members and to aid the parish in religious work. The **Spirituality of Prayer** in the same manner encourages devotion to the Sacred Heart and consists of daily prayers for a special purpose and for the intention of the Holy Father. Members who were enrolled in this society are asked to take an active part and perform the duties imposed on them.

The **Young Ladies' Society** offers all single ladies of our parish special advantages in the spiritual and social lines. The monthly meetings held in the church with sermon and benediction and the business meeting in the hall have proved most interesting and beneficial during the past year. Devotion to the Blessed Virgin and a greater knowledge of our faith and morals, as well as advice to counteract the present day evils have been stressed by the Moderator.

In the same manner the **Sacred Heart Society** has worked for the interest of the married women of our parish. Many young married women have taken greater interest in this society; the meetings also have been well attended and the organization has assisted the church on many occasions.

The **Young Men's Club** has existed since 1939, being one of the most successful of its kind in the diocese. It was organized for the spiritual and recreational welfare of our men of the parish. It has greatly assisted the young men in the military service who have spent many happy hours in our club quarters. The activities of the Knights of St. John and Ladies' Auxiliary are too well known for comment, and it is true that our Commandery has been one of the most active in the city.

The **Boy Scouts, Troop 200**, has had a large and active membership with an extensive program for the spiritual and physical welfare of the young boys under the care of experienced officers.

The **Girl Scouts**, which was organized later, has worked in a similar manner among the young girls of the parish. The **Flower Guild** deserves great praise for the work it has done in supplying our church with many necessary articles needed for the altar. It is hoped that many more will assist this fine organization during the coming year.

The **St. Herman's Society** is the largest and most active among the societies for sick benefits with a great record of practical service among the men of the parish. Many young men have joined this organization during the past year. St. Joseph's and St. Boniface Society (closed) have also proved

their usefulness during the past fifty years.
