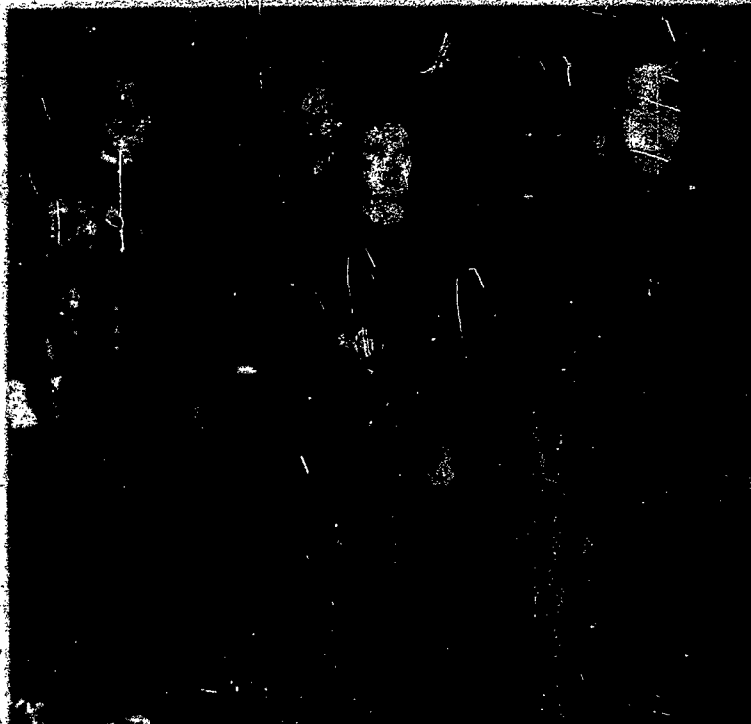

St. Mary's Hospital in Athens Inaugurates Rotating Internship

ATHENS, Ga.—Establishment of the first hospital rotating internship for Athens has been inaugurated by St. Mary's Hospital, conducted by the Missionary Sisters of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

The first interns to take the course are James Patrick Evans, M. D., who comes from Augusta. He received his B. S. degree in medicine from the University of Georgia in 1948 and his Doctor of Medicine from the Medical College of Georgia in 1951; Robert High Swint, M. D., who has his B. S. from Emory University and who graduated from Emory Medical School, Atlanta, in 1951.

Dr. Swint is on the Medical Service now and Dr. Evans begins his internship with the Surgical Service.

The announcement made by St. Mary's stated:

"Modern medical education requires a comprehensive program covering the entire professional life of the physician. An effective, first step must be planned for the years as medical student and as intern. The object of a Rotating Internship, as St. Mary's Hospital offers, is a dual one; it is both to provide efficient resident service for the patients and to round out the medical graduate's training so as to enable

him to enter into the general practice of medicine or provide fundamental work for additional specialty training in medicine or surgery.

The Interns Committee primarily and all members of the Medical Staff take an active interest in all matters affecting the professional and general welfare of the interns."

Holy Father Grants Private Audience to Margaret Truman

VATICAN CITY.—Miss Margaret Truman was welcomed at the Vatican without official formalities but in a manner befitting the daughter of a Head of State and was received in a 20-minute private audience by His Holiness Pope Pius XII. Miss Truman, daughter of President Truman, is touring Europe as a private citizen.

Prior to her audience, Miss Truman called at the North American College in Via dell'Umiltà here where she was greeted by its Rector, Bishop Martin J. O'Connor. He and his assistant, the Rev. Clarence Lafferty, accompanied her to the Vatican, where two American priests attached to the Papal Secretariate of State, Msgr. Joseph F. McGeough and the Rev. John G. Clancy, welcomed her and escorted her to the Papal apartments.

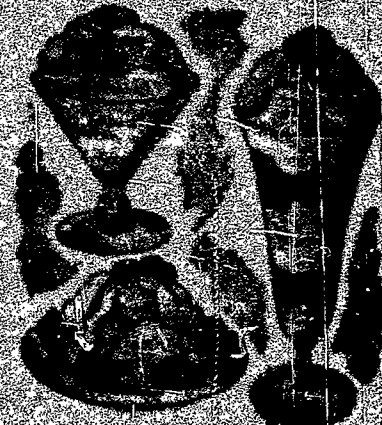
There, Miss Truman was received by Baron de Waresheim de Flory, Papal Chamberlain of Cape and Sword, who conducted her to the Holy Father's private library. Msgr. Mario Naselli Rocca, Papal Chamberlain, announced the visitor to the Pontiff. No other persons accompanied Miss Truman during the audience nor were presented to the Pope afterwards. Prince Margantonio Pacelli, nephew of His Holiness, was captain of the detail of the Noble Guard on duty that morning.

During the audience, the Supreme Pontiff presented to Miss Truman, as a souvenir of her visit, a miniature of the Madonna of Sorbus. The Pope asked Miss Truman to deliver his particular greetings and good wishes to her father and mother.

After the audience, Bishop O'Connor and Father Lafferty accompanied Miss Truman on a drive through the Vatican gardens and took her on a brief tour of inspection of the new North American college, now under construction on the Janiculum Hill overlooking the City of Rome. Following her return to the college at Via dell'Umiltà and a brief visit there, Miss Truman went in a car of the United States Embassy to the residence of U. S. Ambassador James C. Dunn, where she was staying during her visit to Rome.

Miss Truman declared herself impressed by the gracious kindness of the Holy Father and by his attitude for America.

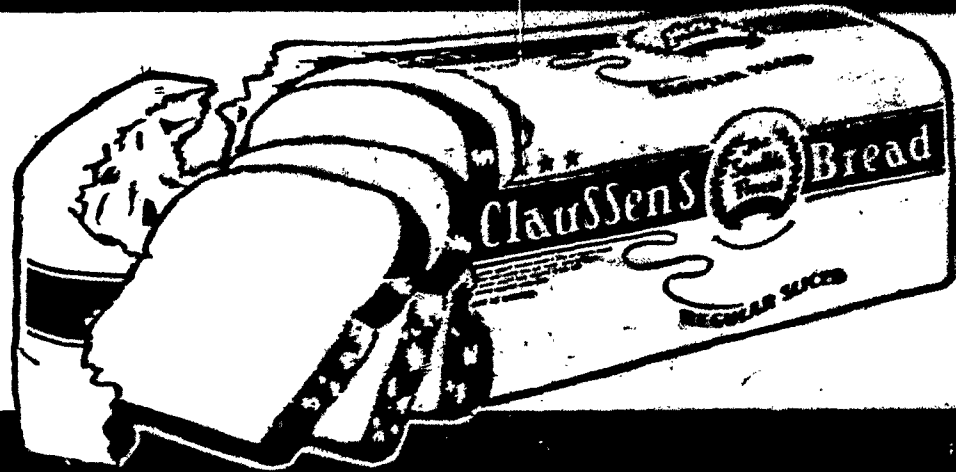
