# Cites Catholic Duty In Divorce Matters

TOLEDO. - (NC) - The widespread evil of divorce and "consequent danger that the ill-instructed Catholic may unwittingly become a party to the sins of others," has prempted the Most Rev. Karl J. Alter, Bishop of To-

is permitted on the following grounds: "I. When the marriage in question is only a civil contract, not witnessed by a priest and therefore invalid from the beginning; 2. When the marriage, though seemingly valid from the beginning, has after proper ecclesidstical trial been found to have been invalid from the beginning because of diriment impediment such as fear or force, and; 5. When the Bishop has under the prescriptions of Canon law, given one party of a valid marriage permission quate means of protecting proper-ty, safeguarding the rights of chil-dren or remedying some other unbearable condition."

Birbon Alter said & Catholic lawyer may accept a divorce case under any of the three outlined conditions, but may not accept a case merely because of his client's difficulty or on the reasoning that if he does not take it another lawyer will. A Catholic judge may act in a divorce case as long as he does not intend his decision to determine the conscientious obligations of the parties to the marriage but merely to decide the civil effects of statutes.
