Retreat Dedicated To 'Our Lady of Fatima' Conducted At Hornell

HORNELL.—A parish Retreat dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, under her title "Our Lady of Fatima," is taking place this week in St. Ann's Church. Retreat exercises are being conducted by the Rev. John H. Healy, O.P., P.O. of the Dominican Fathers.

Father Healy has taken as his theme for evening sessions, "The Holy Rosary," with meditations and conclusions which apply to everyday living. Evening sessions consist of Rosary, Benediction and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. A short instruction is given by Father Healy after the 6:30 o'clock and 8:00 Masses each morning.

The history of the beautiful devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary dates from the year 1917. In letters distributed to all parishes during the past week the story of the devotion is given as follows:

ANSWERING MARY'S REQUEST

"In this little village of Fatima, Portugal, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to three small children six times during the year 1917. The first apparition occurred on May 13 and the last on October 13. Mary made known to the children, whose ages were ten, nine and seven, that God wished to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart."

"Appearing while World War I was still raging, Mary warned that unless the world consecrates itself to her Immaculate Heart, the present war, which the foretold, will drag on with errors spreading throughout the world, persecution, martyrdom, and destruction of nations. She also declared that Russia would be converted at the end of the war."

"Her statement, made on July 13, 1917, is as follows: 'God wishes to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart. If people do what I have told you, many souls will be saved and will find peace. The war is going to end, but if people do not cease to offend God, not much time will elapse and precisely during the next pontificate another and more terrible war will commence. When night, illuminated by an unknown light, is seen, know that that is the signal which God gives you that the chastisement of the world is at hand through war, famine, and persecution of the Church and of the Holy Father. To avoid this I ask for the consecration of the world to my Immaculate Heart and Communion in Separation on the first Saturday of each month.'

"If my requests are heard, Russia will be converted and there will be peace. Otherwise, great errors will spread throughout the world, giving rise to wars and persecutions against the Church; the good will suffer martyrdom, and the Holy Father will have to suffer much; different nations will be destroyed; but in the end my Immaculate Heart will triumph; the Holy Father will consecrate Russia to me; Russia will be converted, and an era of peace will be granted to humanity."

"An ecclesiastical commission was appointed to investigate the Fatima apparitions, and, in 1930, they were declared worthy of belief, and devotion to Our Lady of Fatima was approved. Last fall, when the 25th anniversary of the apparitions was being solemnly observed in Portugal, Pope Pius XII in a radio broadcast addressed those attending and consecrated the whole world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. At the same time he urged all Christians to perform this consecration individually. Since that time many of the faithful throughout the world have followed his example. In England some of the Bishops have consecrated their dioceses to the Immaculate Heart of Mary with appropriate solemnity. Others throughout the world have done likewise. Pastors of parishes have consecrated their flocks to Mary.

"The Hierarchy recently selected Aug. 15, the Feast of Mary's Assumption into heaven, as the day for the consecration of that nation to her. All the dioceses of that Catholic country will join in the dedication."
