Mobilize Spiritually To Fight Delinquency

BURLINGTON, Vt.—Contending that youthful delinquency is the nation's No. 1 social problem, the Rev. Thomas Connor, Director of the Catholic Youth Organization for the Diocese of Burlington, in a radio address declared the fundamental cause of the evil is irreligion in the home, and he urges in a return to religion, through religious education, parental example and the restoration of Christian homelife.

The most vital part of the job in accomplishing these aims, Father Connor asserted, "must be done right here at home" by the individual, the family, the church, the school, the community and the nation. Mobilization toward the establishment of the post-war world order must begin now, he said, and the most important of all mobilizations is spiritual mobilization.
