### 8,922,993 Attend November Services Of Army Chaplains

WASHINGTON, D. C.—A total of 133,261 religious services were conducted by U. S. Army Chaplains during the month of November and were attended by 8,922,993 persons, according to statistics released by the War Department from the office of the Rt. Rev. Msgr. William A. Arnold, Brigadier General and Chief of Chaplains.

The report also included the following activities of chaplains for the month: Communion and sacramental occasions 22,295; parades, 4,116; guardhouse and hospital visits 20,372; pastoral contacts—persons reached, 6,908,872.
