George Croston and Bob Murray were on the refreshments committee.

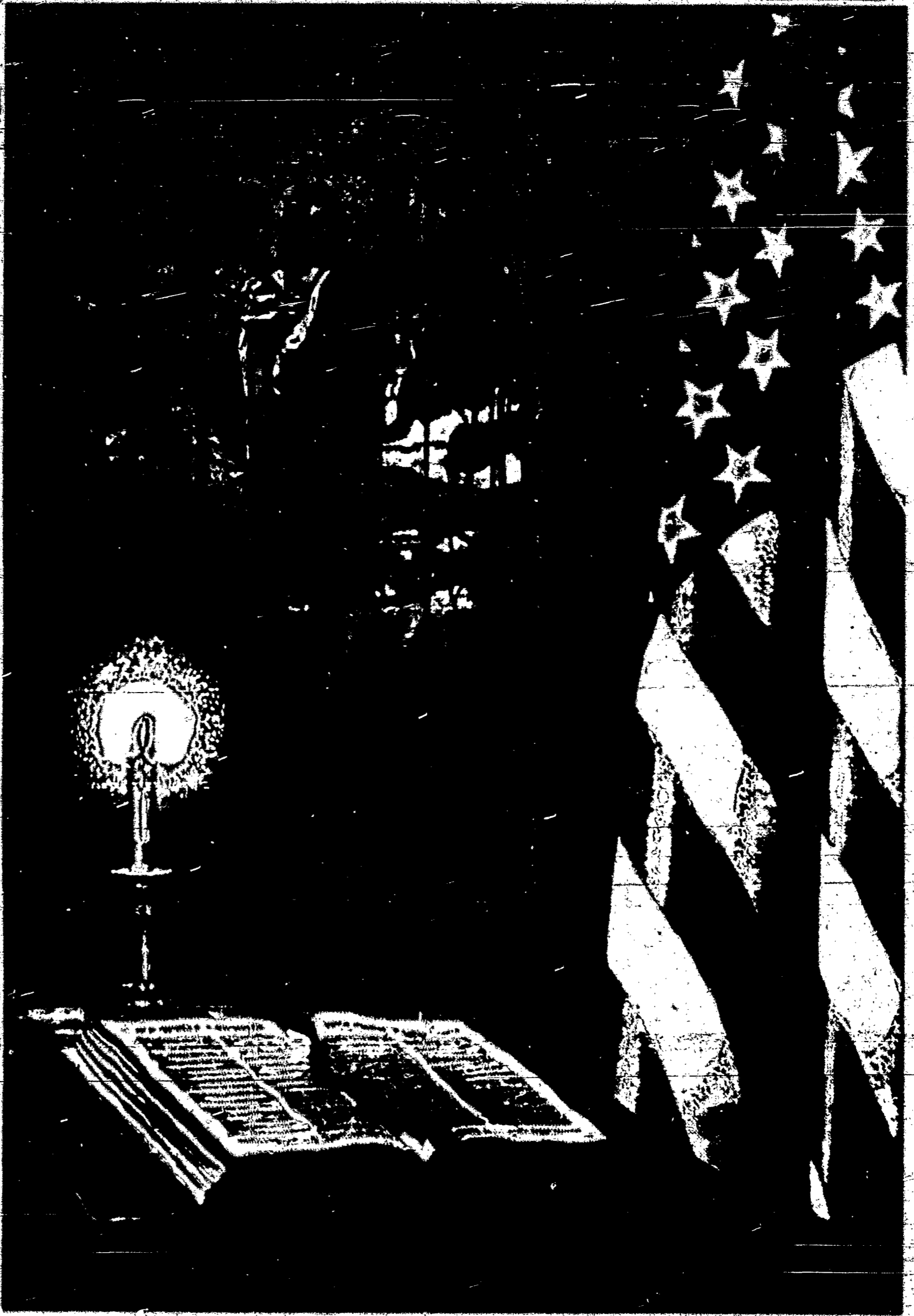
ST. JOHN OF MATHIA
