Better Booking Set For Crosby Film Depicting Parish Life

"Going My Way," new Paramount film of Catholic parish life and starring Bing Crosby in the lead role of a Catholic priest is finished but its release for public showing will be delayed.

Reason for the postponement is that Paramount now suspects that "Going My Way" is a much better picture than the studio had anticipated. Therefore, the Crosby film is not to be sold, as originally intended, as one of a group of five films, but will be released as a special.

Portraying the simple parish experiences of three typical priests, "Going My Way," has been acclaimed by West Coast critics who have had the privilege of a preview.

Father Devlin, who acted in an advisory capacity during the pic-

ture's production, declares it to be "the best comedy that he has seen in years."

From Los Angeles, William H. Mooring, a Catholic motion picture editor, reported:

"My own opinion is that it will be even more interesting to non-Catholics than to Catholics and will do a great deal to break down resistance (left by many non-Catholic who have questions to ask but lack the courage to face a Priest and ask them). Catholics do not always make allowances for the prejudices against the priesthood which (speaking from experience) stand like anti-tank fortifications against the slow forward march of the would-be convert. Knock them down and the rest is easy."

Then came the day when I had to leave. Preacher, I couldn't stand it any longer. I know you may think I am a fool, but I broke down and cried like a baby. I just couldn't help it. It wasn't because I was having to leave. I didn't mind that so much. I know that I might never see them again. But that wasn't what worried me. I just had to cry to think that my own Mother and Dad were not in the least interested in my salvation.
