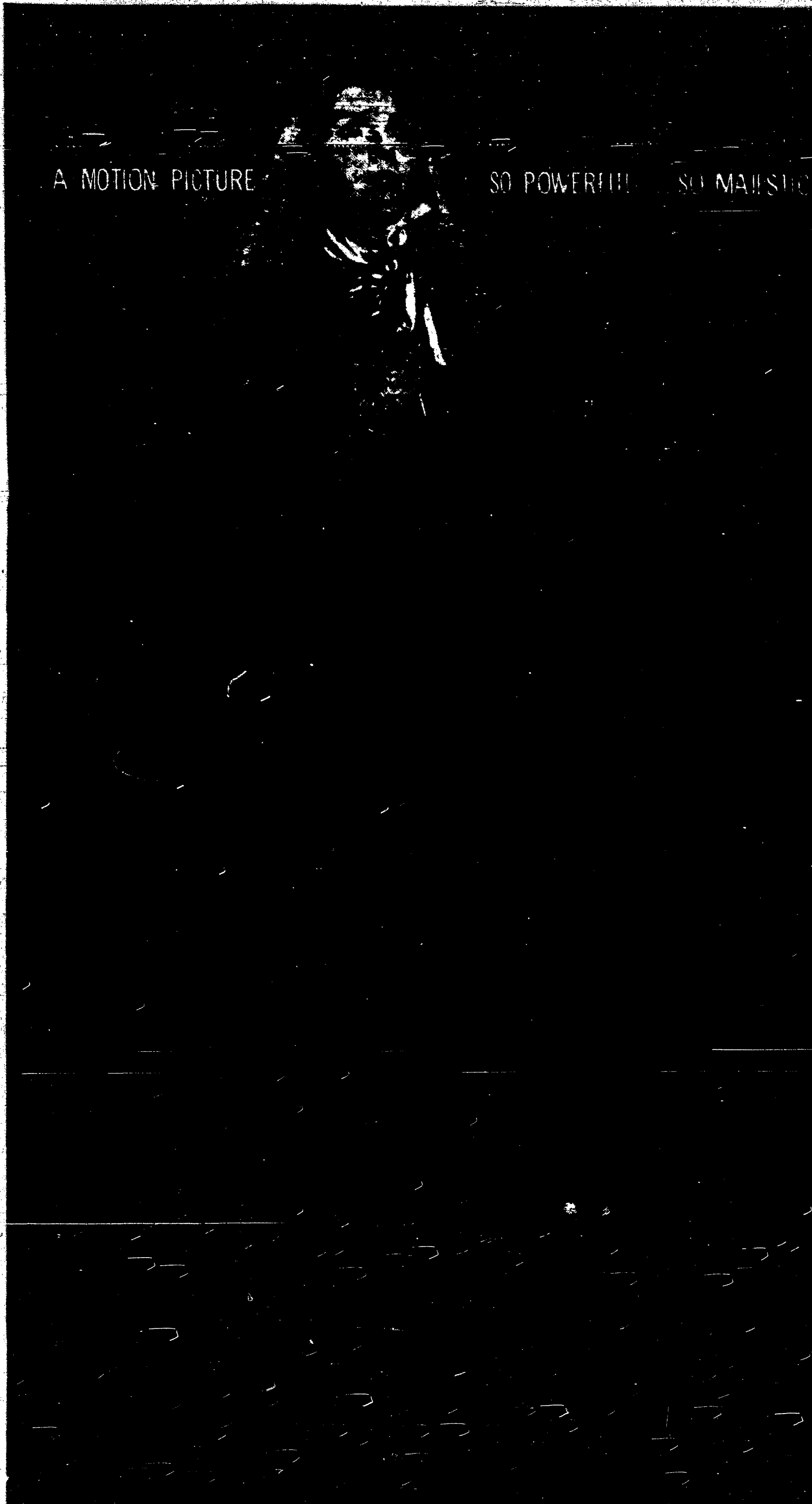
Appreciation
