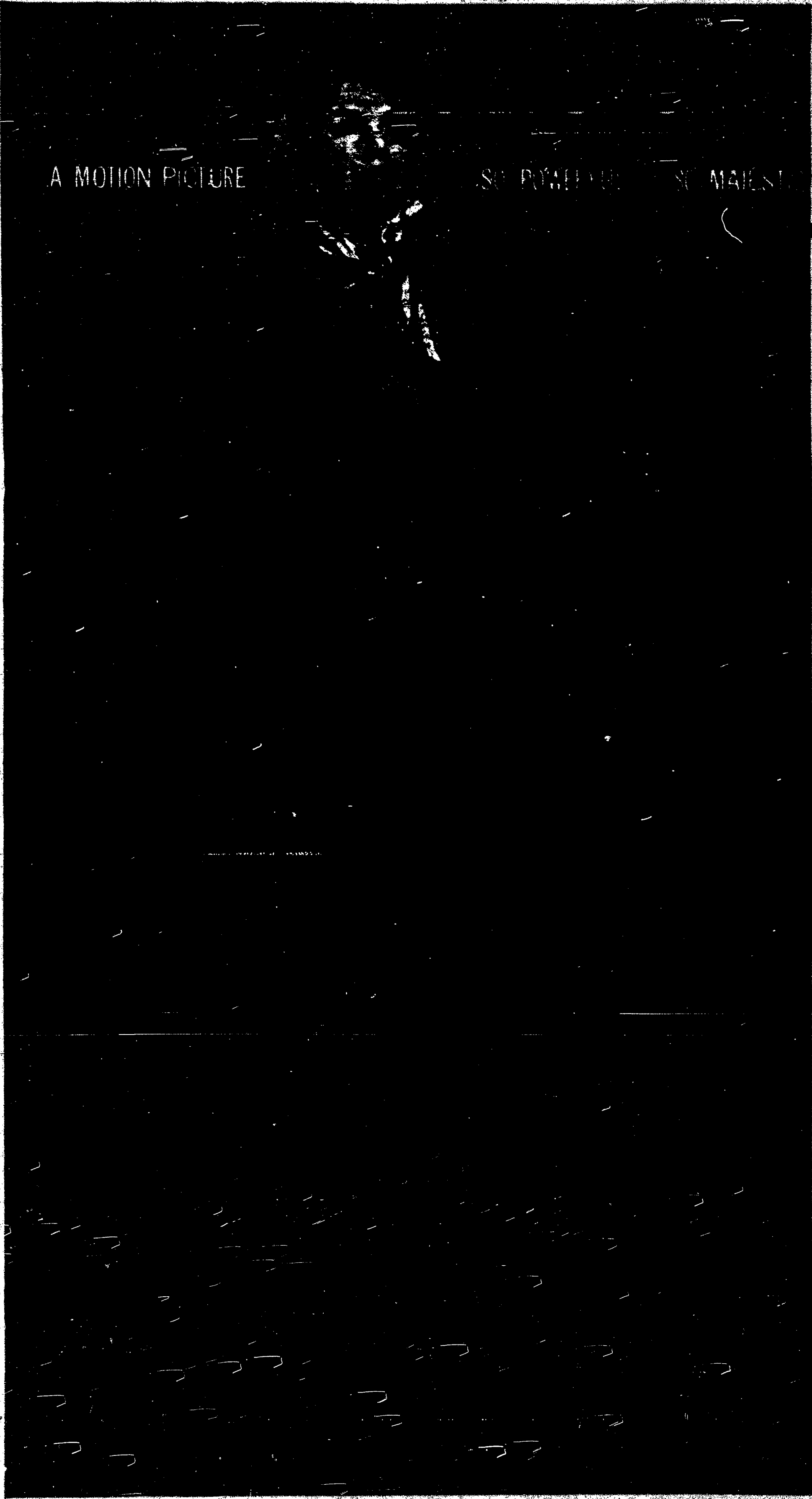
Appreciation
