They are: Staff Sgt. Chester E. Ryan, stationed with the WAC at Camp Miles Standish; Staff Sgt. William H. Ryan, in training with the Infantry at Camp McClelland, Ala.; Staff Sgt. Robert E. Ryan, recently returned from England where he served with the U. S. Air Forces; Pte. John Fifth Grade Thomas H. Ryan who has just returned after service in the Aleutians.

Corporal Charles J. Schwartz, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Schwartz, 68 W. Third St., a veteran of two years and a half in the Pacific area, as a member of an artillery outfit, is spending a 21 day furlough with his parents.

The promotion was awarded to the young man upon his return to California after a leave spent in


