Students Report Family Prayers ST. MARY'S Skipped in Homes

ALBANY, N. Y .-- Family prayer is neglected in the average Catholic home, according to "an amazing majority" of students at the Vincentian Summer High School here who participated in a questionnaire sponsored by The Evangelist,

official organ of Albany Diocese. Recitation of the Rosary by the family group, and the saying of Ciraco before and after meals were "especially mentioned" as lacking, the publication revealed.

Over 90 per cent of the replies expressed the belief that training in Catholic high schools had "made thom a better Catholic man or woman;" 80 per cent declared that this training had been stifficient to enable them "to explain the Mass to a non-Catholic of their own

The mestionnaire disclosed that 10 per cent of the boys and girls queried noted perental ladifference to the presence of "treatly magn-sines" and the lack of interest in Catholic periodicals in the home; a few complained of reticence at home-in regard-to instruction on multers of sex; and a majority felt that "the Catholic school should go beyond its line of duly and make up-is, some vray for vractime de- fedis in home training."
