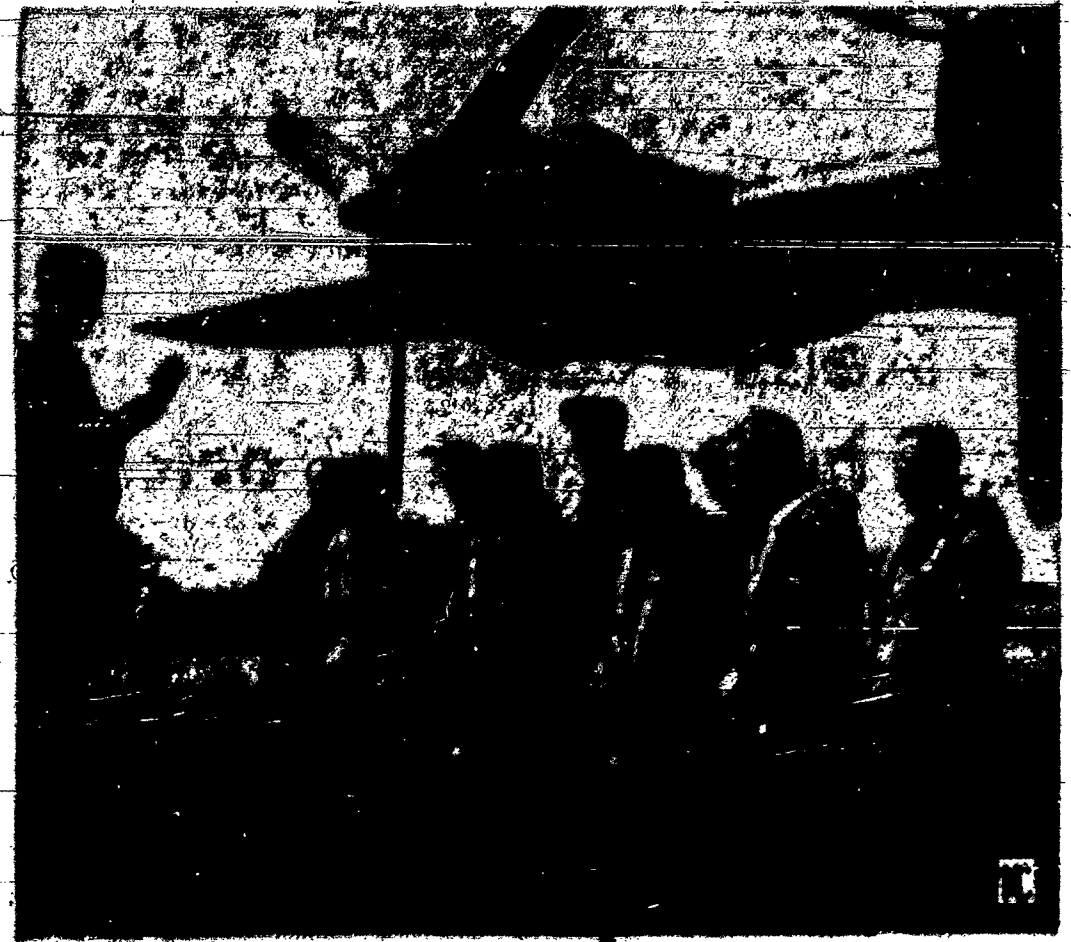

Report Over 80 Franciscan Conventuals Slain in Poland

LONDON.—(NC)—The Order of Friars Minor Conventuals in Poland has suffered great losses during the present conflict, according to information received here by KAP, Polish Catholic Press Agency.

Approximately 90 priests and 50 lay brothers have been slain, according to the information received. The convents at Radomsk, Warsaw, Wilno, Lwow and Kosow have been destroyed, the report stated. All the priests and Brothers who were formerly stationed at the following convents are reported to have been killed: Wilno, Haliu, Kosow, Skaryzako-Kamienna, Poznan and Grodno.
