"Does it seem easier to us to read that in ancient Rome and Greece and, in more primitive times, in Asia, before we were abandoned, because they weren't willing to prove their faith once had no right that we could be delivered by a good Christian husband? Christ, His changed that. Wherever Christian faith prevails, woman is given a honored personality."

The first Christians, following the example of Jesus, had so high a regard for their mother, that they early turned her as the Queen of Humanity. We see it in the specimens of Christian art, that Mary quite as often as the Saviour.

And through the centuries, thousands of glorious Renaissance masterpieces by Raphael, Corregio, and the like. In our own day, we dare say there is not a Catholic Church in the world without its statue or little icon of honor to the Blessed Mother.

AS PARENTS DIES

You probably know we Catholics are only doing as our parents have always done. We knew up to the time of our parents, before the time of Jesus did Himself. We do not believe in new fangled beliefs. If we honor our Blessed Mother, it is because we have always honored her.

Mary is an ideal of purity for our men and women alike. Our mothers, her memory and honor, have not hesitated to welcome children into their homes, recalling the story it would have been for her if she had raised God's child. In the Orient we have almost a beast of burden. In Russia and to some extent in this country we find her taking a place in the factory and in the office claiming equality with man. What a come-down! She can be man's equal easily for man has always thought of womanhood as being much better than himself, basing his conviction on devotion to Our Lady. Doesn't it prove then that honor paid to Mary honors womanhood?

**Bishops Send M. of C. Head
To Italy for Survey**

WASHINGTON (CNS) — Francis P. Mallon, Supreme Knight of the Knights of Columbus and chairman of the Executive Committee, National Catholic Community Service, has gone to Europe at the direction of the Administrative Board of Bishops of the National Catholic Welfare Conference. It is unreported how long he will remain.

Mr. Mallon will make a survey of the present work of the United Catholic Relief agencies in Italy. He also will study programs for welfare work in Italy, the Italian economy, and the Italian political situation.
