Home Said Basis Of Patriotism

SANTIAGO, CHILE — Bilingual was placed on the house at the residence of Bishop and Mrs. James M. McGuire, Chairman of the National Committee of the Catholic Women's Bureau of Chilean Catholic Action, held at Talca and organized by 1,000 women.

At the Mass which closed the Congress, His Excellency the Most Rev. Maurice Tolosa, Papal Nuncio to Chile, addressed the delegates to certify their work as a pledge of "unity, brotherhood, and love."

"We should always remember," Archbishop McGuire said, "why the Lord made woman the source of the world, the repository of man and the source of charity." He warned against parents and persons that tend to take children away from the care and guidance of their mothers and lead them into the streets where they become "human parasites, thinking only of destruction and enjoyment, in turn provocative of human and even national disasters."

"The future of a people," he added, "depends upon the solidity and stability of their homes."
