

New Postal Notes Planned

Postmaster General Walker announced that a contract has been awarded for the manufacture of 100,000,000 Postal Notes and efforts are being made to place this new and inexpensive type of money order on sale at all of the 1,000 First Class Post Offices by approximately January 1, 1945.

The new type of money order will be made available to post offices other than of the first class as rapidly as adequate stocks of Postal Notes come from the presses. However, from the beginning they may be cashed at any

post office in the United States. Eighteen denominations of stamps will be issued in connection with the Postal Notes. They are 1¢, 2¢, 3¢, 4¢, 5¢, 6¢, 8¢, 10¢, 12¢, 15¢, 18¢, 20¢, 25¢, 30¢, 35¢, 40¢, 50¢, 60¢, 75¢, 85¢, \$1.00.

The new Postal Note is designed as a safe, convenient and economical way of sending through the mails amounts of money not exceeding \$10. Simplified methods of sale and accounting makes it possible to handle the Notes at a minimum cost.

form for it. The conventional money order is not being displaced by the new Note.

This is the procedure that will be followed when Postal Notes become available: A person who wants a Postal Note of \$1.00 will go to the money order window. The clerk will tell of the and a 4¢ stamp to a 1¢ Postal Note, and exchange the Note for \$1.00. There are no applications for the purchaser to fill out, no writing to be done by the clerk. The purchaser leaves the window, writes in the name of the payee on the Note, attaches his record stub on which he records the payee's name, and mails the Postal Note. The Note is to a pre-punched calculating card form.

Roger Bresnahan's Funeral Conducted in Toledo

TOLEDO, O. (INS) — Funeral services were held at 9 A. M. (Thursday) in Toledo's Blessed Sacrament Church for Roger Bresnahan, 66, baseball's "Duke of Tralee" who died of a heart attack in his Toledo home Monday.

For almost a third of a century Bresnahan was active as catcher, manager, coach or baseball club owner. His greatest starring role was with the New York Giants from 1902 to 1906 when he was the battery mate of the late Christy Mathewson. Bresnahan retired from baseball in 1931. He was born in Tralee, Ireland, in 1879.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Gertrude Bresnahan, and a daughter, Marian.

Far East Chaplains Given Confirmation Faculty by Pontiff

LONDON (INC) — All Allied chaplains working in India and South-East Asia Commands have been granted by the Holy Father the faculty to administrator Confirmation, announces Archbishop Thomas Roberts, S. J., of Bombay, in a special letter to the Allied Forces under his spiritual jurisdiction as Military Delegate for these commands.

"Many," writes the Archbishop in his letter, a copy of which has now reached London, "will benefit by the new extension of power."

Expect Maryknoll Superior in Kunming

KUNMING, China (INC) — The Most Rev. James D. Walsh, Superior General of the Maryknoll Fathers, is expected to arrive here this week according to word received by the Rev. Mark Trennan, Maryknoll director in Chungking.

Bishop Walsh left here two months ago to visit the Maryknoll Missions in South China. His departure was at the time of the Japanese drive to split China. He traveled by plane over the Japanese lines and made his way by foot to the Maryknoll Kaying mission.

Since then no word has been received from Bishop Walsh until the present message announced that he expects to return to Kunming in early December.
