Nurse Reports to Navy

CORNING—Decorated for gallantry, a wounded infantryman has returned home, a nurse from here has joined the Navy and reports have come from Italy and Germany of

Pfc. Donald Somer, 18, arrived recently at the home of his mother, Mrs. Florence Somer, 321 Woodview Ave., to spend a few days after being discharged from Marine Hospital, Staten Island. He will report Jan. 8 at Eastland General Hospital, Atlantic City, for further treatment.

The young soldier was returned to the United States on Dec. 1 for hospitalization after being wounded on Oct. 15 at Cassino by a bursting mortar shell. He saw action with the Infantry for 18 months before his injury.

In addition to the Order of the Purple Heart Pfc. Somer also received the Croix de Guerre for action under fire in Italy, the Bronze Star for gallantry in action of Cassino and the Mediterranean Theater Ribbon with battle stars for action at Cassino and Rome.

He is a graduate of St. Patrick's Parochial School and attended Corning Free Academy.

Mrs. Edna Giarino, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Giarino, of 75 W. William St., reported on January 3 at Sampson Naval Training Center, where she will undergo training with the Naval Nurse Corps. She was recently commissioned an ensign.

A graduate of St. Joseph's Hospital Training School for Nurses in the class of 1944, Miss Giarino enlists in the Navy in August. She is a graduate of St. Vincent de Paul's Parochial School, and Northside High School where she was an honor student and active in many school projects.

During the polo epidemic Miss Giarino worked at Corning Hospital until her resignation recently she did general duty at the Hospital.

Pvt. Peter Schutte, 28 W. Erie Ave., is a member of the 36th Infantry Regiment, which took part recently in the fight for Mt. Castellana in Northern Italy. The unit held its position in spite of continual attack by the Germans for seven days.

Cpl. Michael Hayes, son of Mr. and Mrs. George Hayes, 266 Park Ave., has sent his parents a parcel which contained captured German equipment, including a bag, fur coat, belt and bayonet, as well as pins and medals. He is serving with a cavalry regiment in the Front Line in Germany.
