When in her (own) words, she joined the Catholic church, she was of Catholic ancestry and seemed to take easily to the faith. But a few years later in another city, she married a Kimmman and it was the fear of her life that he would find out she had been a Catholic. She set out to prove how much she detested Catholicism by her activities against it. Her marriage brought her wealth and position and a beautiful and idealized daughter, who was reared to believe money and position were all that counted.

Less than two years ago death stood at this mother's side. It was then that her thoughts and her heart went back to the faith of her girlhood. She wanted a priest, yet she dared not ask for him, knowing he would not be allowed in the house. Silently she prayed for another chance. A Catholic friend, informed a priest of her plight, and he offered a Mass for her. The doctors said a miracle had happened. After having been given but a few hours to live, she recovered. Then she again forgot all about her faith and followed the same old trail, too great a coward to make use of the chance God had given her.

A SECOND CALL.
During the recent holidays, her daughter met with a fearful accident resulting in internal injuries and a dreadfully cut and bruised face. Immediately her mother frantically called the same Catholic friend and begged "Call Father . . . and beg him to pray for me and for me." Again the good priest responded; again he offered Mass. At the hour of the Mass she was a shade better. Still later she became conscious, but the outcome, because of complications that were in the air, was still in doubt. Father is still praying—and so is that mother, praying even more fervently than she did before. How will it all end?

It leaves many things about which we may well wonder. What will this mother finally do about the Faith she knows is right, to which she turns in her hour of trouble and then works against when all is well? Pale and wan, the girl is fighting for her life.
