Bishop Promotes Film in Springfield Schools

SPRINGFIELD, ILL. (INC.) — The audio-visual system of education will be introduced in Catholic schools here beginning next summer, it is revealed in a letter addressed by the Most Rev. James A. Griffin, Bishop of Springfield in Illinois, to the priests and school Sisters of the diocese.

"The Catholic system is pro-

gressive in the best sense," Bishop Griffin declared. "It uses any aid to education that produces results. Audio-visual is a working educational device. G.E. Joe has found that out. The use of the motion picture is not a fad, but an aid that has come to stay."

The Diocese is prepared to back
