

### Bishop Promotes Films in Springfield Schools

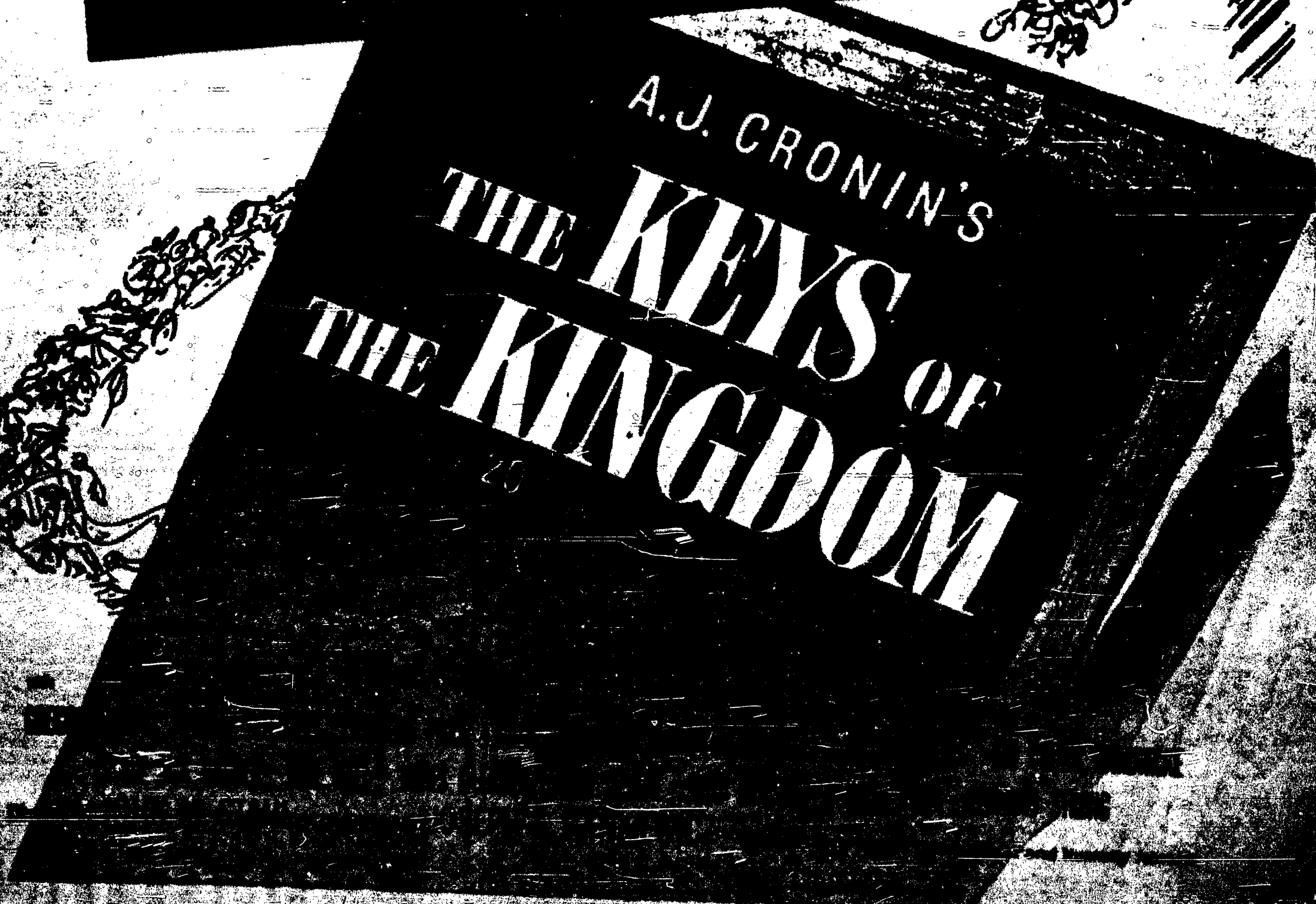
### Two Phases on Peace
