Vocations Plentiful, Missioner Tells Why Brazil Needs Priests

WASHINGTON (NC) — Although Brazil is the largest Catholic country in the Western Hemisphere, its crying need in for priests and mill boys priests, according to the Rev. Francis A. Connor, a Missionary Father of Our Lady of La Salette. Father Connor has returned to this country after spending twelve years in Southern Brazil, which he describes as the coming nation of the future.

He said it is difficult to understand the critical need for priests in Brazil, which has more than 37,000,000 Catholics in its population of more than 41,000,000, and the realization is made the more difficult by the fact that vocations to the priesthood and religious life are at present numerous throughout the nation.

The country has virtually no clergy at all compared to its vastness. Father Connor explained. "There are only 6,000 priests to administer to the large Catholic population. The difficulty dates back more than half a century to the bloodless persecution of the Church in the warring days of the Brazilian Empire. It was then that seminaries and other religious institutions were virtually closed by a decree of the Empire which forbade new students to enter seminaries and other Catholic institutions and which banned the entry of priests and religious into the country. The effect of that prohibition and the passage of time reduced the native clergy to virtually nothing.

"When the country again was opened to priests and religious," Father Connor continued, "it was a matter of years before these missionaries could acclimate themselves and gain the confidence of the people. Vocations are plentiful now, and the future looks bright, but Brazil needs immediate help and will continue to need it until the native clergy again is restored to a position to care for the country's needs."

MEEK-VOCED MAN UPSETS ANGLICAN RITE PROTESTING PRELATE'S APPOINTMENT

LONDON — An age-old tradition in the Crypt of St. Paul's Cathedral, where ecclesiastical dignitaries gathered in their flowing robes to confirm the election of a new Anglican Archbishop of Canterbury, was ruckled to its foundations on last Friday when a meek-voiced individual tossed a verbal bombshell into the proceedings.

As the vicars converged around the Rt. Rev. Geoffrey F. Fisher, 80th Archbishop to be installed, a 70-year-old man shouted in a high-pitched voice: "This appointment does not meet the people's approval because, as I said the other morning, that man and will not support the preferences of those who believe there is a policy of compromise. Nor has the church had any say in the election of a new Archbishop. I would urge you solemnly and solemnly to think twice before proceeding."

17,376,240 Shrine Pilgrims

QUEBEC (NC) — Since the first pilgrimage back in 1406 and including the 1944 season, there have been 17,376,240 persons who have come to pray at the St. Anne de Beaupre shrine.

During the last season there were 223,000 pilgrims, this being an increase of 20,000 over the 1943 figures. There were 16 pilgrimages in 1944 and 21,000 automobiles visited the shrine.

The total number of pilgrims in 1944 was the first gain since the war. Prior to 1939 the number of pilgrims to this internationally known shrine was as high as 600,000 in one season.

With the war came various travel restrictions and other duties which prevented many from visiting the shrine.
