Four Hornell Boys Die, 4 Missing, on War Fronts

HORNELL. St. Ann's Church service flag now bears 19 Gold Stars, with the official reporting of four more parishioners killed in action within slightly more than a month's time. Four other boys from St. Ann's have been recently reported missing in action.

Second Lieut. Donald Berry, son of Mr. and Mrs. Louis J. Berry, lost his life in Germany December 23. He was a member of the Infantry, Hedge's First Army, and had been overseas only a few months. Lieutenant Berry enlisted in June, 1943, and received his commission in July 1944. Another brother, First Lieut. Paul Berry, has completed his missions as a pilot of a B-17 with the 8th Air Force, and is now spending his leave at his home.

Private Elmer E. Cuddeback, a member of the U. S. Armored Infantry Division, was killed in action in Belgium on Christmas Day. He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Cuddeback, of Danville, and his wife is the former Miss Ruth Donahue of Hornell.

Private Cuddeback enlisted in the Army December 2, 1942, and went overseas in June, 1944. Three months later, he was wounded in action in Germany. He returned to active duty on November 20 and was reported killed a month later.

Captain Francis Mitchell, son of Mr. Anna Mitchell and the late

Thomas J. Mitchell, was killed in action in France Jan. 11. He had been in service with the Infantry since 1940, and went overseas six months ago. He was a member of the Seventh Army in France. After being wounded in action in December Captain Mitchell had returned to duty a short time ago. He was awarded the Purple Heart and the Combat Infantryman's Badge.
