Fr. Brennan's Mass 'Memorable' to G.I. In the Philippines

Midnight Mass offered during a Japanese air raid by Chaplain John Brennan, Redemptorist. Father from St. Joseph's Church, made "a memorable Christmas Eve" for nearly 400 Americans stationed in the Philippines, according to a letter from a Michigan G.I.

It was Christmas eve on one of the Philippines Islands which recently had been taken by the American soldiers. Nearly 400 G.I.s, including Catholics, Jews and Protestants mingled with the natives in the clearing, popularly known as "Radio City," waiting for midnight Mass to be offered by Father Brennan.

Suddenly there was an alert. The crowd scattered only to return about an hour later when the all clear signal sounded. Just as the soldiers' choir, augmented by a group of native girls, was about to start the Christmas carols, another alert sounded. It was then past midnight and when it seemed the attack was ended, Father Brennan called the choir onto the stage and announced that the Mass would begin.

"You could say it was the grace of God -- it couldn't be beat anything else," writes Sgt. Lester L. Kopecky, who was a member of the soldiers' choir. "It was wonderful just thinking that we're out here, with the Jap planes overhead, the Mass still went on."

The mass were there with helmets and guns. The uniforms weren't polished shiny and some hats and ties -- those boys come to honor the Little Infant just as they were. We had Colored troops, Protestants, Greeks and even some Negro boys at the Mass. That's what a remarkable Christmas Eve it was."
