1 Dies, 3 Wounded in War Areas

One Elmiran has given his life and three have been reported injured, according to word received by their families during the past week.

Mrs. Catherine Gotoe of 555 Grove Street, has been informed by the War Department that her husband, Seaman 1/c William Gotoe, 21, died on March 6, as a result of drowning. The information was received by telegram and stated that Seaman Gotoe's body had been recovered and was buried in a cemetery outside the United States.

Seaman Gotoe had notified his family that he expected to leave for overseas duty late in February as he had been assigned to the LST boat and Mrs. Gotoe recently received a letter from him, bearing a San Francisco Fleet Post Office address. The letter was postmarked March 6, the day on which the War Department stated he met his death.

Seaman Gotoe had been in the Navy since February, 1944. He received his training at Key West and Camp Perry in Florida and at Norfolk, Va., and was on his first sea try, when he lost his life.

A graduate of St. Anthony's School Seaman Gotoe attended the Academy and was employed at the Tolomeo Dry Cleaners before he entered the service. He was a member of the Holy Name Society of St. Patrick's Church where a Requiem High Mass will be offered for him on Friday, March 14, at 8:30 a.m.

Besides his wife, Seaman Gotoe is survived by two children, Donald, age 2, and Michael, age 1; his mother, Mrs. Mary Gotoe, 505 Magee Street, and several sisters and one brother.

Mrs. Margaret Dombecki of 705 West Church Street has been informed that her husband, T/Sgt Joseph P. Dombecki, was wounded in action in Japan, January 24.

He entered the service in November, 1942, and was with a Tank Battalion. He received his training at Camp Chester, Ark., and Camp Howze, Tex., and went overseas in July, 1944. A graduate of St. Cecilia's School and the Academy, T/Sgt Dombecki was employed as the Harbor Machine shop before he entered the service. He is the son of Mrs. Martha Dombecki, 125 Stewart Street and a member of St. John's Parish.

Chemung County's first casualty on Iwo Jima was reported this week when Mr. and Mrs. John Augustine, 115 Fifth Street, received word from the War Department, that their son, Pvt. Stanley Augustine, 18, was wounded during the recent landings on the island.

A member of the Third Marine Division, Pvt. Augustine has been in the service one year and has been in the South Pacific Area since last June. He was graduated from St. Cecilia's School and the Academy and worked at the Harbor Machine Works before he entered the service.

Mr. and Mrs. Augustine have been active in the various fraternal organizations in the community.

Lieutenant Didas was graduated from St. Ann's School, Hornell High School and Rochester Business Institute. Entering the Air Corps February, 1942, he trained at Nashville, Tenn., Georgia and Alabama and was commissioned a second Lieutenant at Jacksonville, Fla.

He went overseas in August, 1943, and was stationed in France where he was a fighter pilot on a Thunderbolt.

Besides his parents, he is survived by three sisters, Mary Agnes and Peggy Didas at home and Connie Didas of Rochester; a grandmother, Mrs. Fred Wood, of Hornell.
