The American Jesuit Father Anderson, inspector of the Holy Land's schools, tells us that sixty at them will have to close unless we send just hundred dollars for each one!

Bishop George Hakim's orphanage in Nazareth, recently peopled with fifty children snatched from a Mohammedan home, needs urgently one hundred dollars.

In the little Sunday at the School of Olan, where John Knell is agent, are stores of bookkeeping, standing for their missionary society. Father Cullen-Lamille also standing for two hundred and fifty dollars for the close of the school year.

Archbishop Louis Bertram of Jerusalem sent a hundred dollars to pay a debt on a school there. He has had to borrow money to keep it going.

All these and many other duty based missions need urgent help. Because no airplanes come there during the week - if you cannot do much. I have a letter, I have all the things I need.
