**Mission Work Goal of Veterans Becoming Priests, Says Prelate**

Jacksonville (NC) In a stirring appeal to Catholic servicemen who "want to exchange the uniform of their country's service with the noblest uniform of all, the cassock which designates the wearer as an officer of Christ's army," the Most Rev. Joseph P. Hurley, Bishop of Saint Augustine, invited men of military training from Florida or elsewhere who desire to study for the priesthood in this pioneer diocese of the South.

"The nation's fighting men have a clear understanding of what the priesthood means to them," Bishop Hurley declared in a sermon at the ordination of the Rev. Harry Turner in the Immaculate Conception Church here. "Wherever they go the priest is at their side. Priests accompanied them, inspired them, and died with them in the African invasion, in Italy, on the shores of Normandy and on every battlefield in Europe."

"If I am not mistaken, there are hundreds of our best Catholic soldiers who will want to dedicate themselves to God and to the glorious warfare of his Church when they have done their duty to our beloved country. Such men will look to the hardest, most demanding sectors of the Christian battlefield. They will want to be missionaries, they will want to be preachers of the Faith."

**Photographic File to Help Restore Churches**

London (RNS) Speedy restoration of churches and other public buildings damaged in Belgium during the war will be facilitated as the result of an extensive photographic file of Belgian art which has been accumulated since 1940. The work was undertaken by Monsignor P. Goussens, a Catholic prelate, on behalf of the Belgian government.

A total of 100,000 negatives has been added to the state archives to date. Records include 4,000 negatives and 300 color photographs of ancient stained glass church windows which were dismantled and removed for safe keeping. Also on file are 500 photographs of a 19th-century bell tower destroyed by the Germans.

**Unite in Noting Good Friday**

New York (RNS) Originating at San Francisco in 1914 as a laymen's crusade, supported by civic, business, and religious organizations, the Reverent Observance of Good Friday Movement has spread to a number of communities under joint sponsorship of Catholics and Protestants.

Purpose of the movement is to promote wider recognition and greater attendance at the traditional Good Friday three-hour services centered on Christ's Seven Last Words from the Cross, and usually held from 12 noon to 3 p. m. in both Protestant and Catholic churches. This year Good Friday falls on March 30.

**Must De-Nazify Reich By Religion Says Monk**

Paris (RNS) Germany cannot be rebuilt until it has been de-Nazified, with the aid of religion, a German Benedictine monk told a French interrogator attached to the advancing Allied armies in Westphalia.

Interviewed at the Gerleve Abbey in the Munster diocese, the priest said he was one of 100 other monks at the Abbey conscripted at the beginning of the war.

"We found ourselves," he stated, "before the cruellest problem of conscience. As Germans, it was our duty to serve our country. As Christians, it was, without doubt, our duty to abolish pagan Nazism. Germany and Nazism were so bound together that we imagined the destruction of Hitler would be the destruction of Germany. We were wrong, but our duty was not clear."

**Nun Used Penicillin For Jungle Cures**

Bibiaca, Bolivia (RNS) The first penicillin in the Bolivian jungles was administered through a Maryknoll Sister, from Milwaukee, who is a physician.

A small girl was suffering from a severe bone infection. Sister Mary Hirschbeck, the physician, prescribed penicillin as the only hope for a cure.

After considerable search 100,000 units of penicillin were located and immediately flown into the jungle. Half the medicine was given to the girl, the other half to a soldier suffering from gonorrhea. Both cases are now cured.
