## Reds' 'Sniping' at Vatican Seen Setting Stage for San Francisco

Washington — (NC) — Other national groups are looking to the servicemen from a national point of view. Why is it not possible for us to adopt the same approach and the same point of view? Prior to the gathering of the "Big Three" at Yalta and before any announcement was made of delegations reached, Soviet publications such as Pravda, Red Army, Gazette and War and the Working Class, and the Moscow Radio kept up a drumbeat against the Vatican, selecting this or that pretense for abuse and attack. This was interpreted as an attempt on the part of the Russians to discredit in advance any condemnation the Holy See might level against resolutions which the Commissars, in their intended to impose with reference to the Polish question.

Now the San Francisco Conference approaches, and students of such matters here believe they see the first indications of a similar Soviet propaganda barrage against the Holy See. The beginnings of such a campaign is seen in items which have found their way into the press of this country in recent days.

Down Up There  
The first was a broadcast over the Moscow Radio quoted in the newspapers here, which argued the Vatican of trying to save independent fascist leaders from punishment. "In the past and the complete elimination of fascism and the creation of a free and democratic Italy, revolutionary forces loaned for support on the Vatican and clearly no take orders from it," the spokesman said. "The Vatican does not a little to save from punishment a number of fascist leaders based on territories liberated Italy."

While, of course, there is a chance of general nature that the Soviets have "dreamed" against the Vatican on any given Tuesday or Friday or Sunday for years past. They're just that is out on the air to do what they can.

While the Yalta Conference was in progress, and before its conclusion were announced, Moscow gave great prominence to lead. It was transmitted to the country by the attack on the Vatican by a group of Patriarchate against Soviet-supported Russian Orthodox Church. This was while the Patriarch charged that the Vatican sought to shield Nazi Germany from Allied punishment. It is easy to see how this vicious attack could be employed if the Vatican condemned movements from the Yalta Conference, then expected daily.

At almost the same time, anti-American Moscow' denunciators in the world have considerable weight on the stage of World War II. Moscow Ambassador to Rome, who had said at a conference meeting that the Vatican would be shocked were its papal institutions, enormous wealth and noble dynasties, a tremendous danger to world peace and post-war security. Again, it is easily seen how anyone would be taken in by this would take a poor view of any criticism the Vatican might make of the Yalta Conference resolutions, for which the world was then waiting.

A few days before, K. Gorkov, working in the Red Army, had warned that Pope Pius was the embodiment of "fascism," and that he was a tool of Hitler. In addition to the fact that his might have been influenced by the Yalta Conference, he was also influenced by the fact that the Red Army had been instrumental in the removal of Mussolini, and that the Soviets had supported the Italian people for supporting fascism.

New York — (NC) — An outright gift of 3,500 pairs of shoes, specially manufactured for Sisters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul, now engaged in relief work throughout France, was announced here by War Relief Services-National Catholic Welfare Conference.

The gift, received by the N.C.W.C. agency from a large manufacturing firm which prefers to remain anonymous, will provide new footwear for about half of the nuns working among war victims in France. The gift follows a recent statement of Mother Madeline Morris, delegate of the Community in this country, that many of the French Sisters have been carrying on their labors of charity for infants the aged and the destitute, working for months without shoes or with only night-shift coverings on their own feet.
