

Marine Dies on Iwo, Soldier is Wounded

A Catholic Marine sergeant from Elmira has made the supreme sacrifice on Iwo Jima and a soldier was wounded in action, the casualty reports this week stated.

Miss Margaret Johnston, 23 East Market Street, has been informed by the War Department that her son, Sgt. Edward D. Johnston, 24, was killed in action on Iwo Jima on February 21.

A member of the 16th Airborne Division, Sgt. Johnston entered the service in December, 1941, after completing his training in the United States. He was assigned to duty with a gun crew of a destroyer. His ship was on convoy duty in the Atlantic and accompanied the first troops to North Africa. Returning from convoy duty, he transferred to the Paratroopers and had grade 2 jumps when the Paratroopers were disbanded and he was assigned to Camp Pendleton, Calif., where he trained recruits. He requested overseas duty and was put in charge of a machine gun crew and sent to the Hawaiian Islands last summer. Later he was sent to the South Pacific, arriving on Iwo Jima Feb. 19.

Sgt. Johnston was graduated from St. Peter and Paul's School and the Academy and worked at the Eclipse Machine Division before he entered the service. He was prominent in all branches of

Mr. Frazee entered the service on March 15, 1943, and was assigned to the 1st Marine Division. He was graduated from the Central Catholic High School and attended the Ithaca High School for two years.

Besides his parents he is survived by his widow, Mrs. Ethel D. Frazee, who resides with their daughter at 218 N. Allen St., two sisters, Miss Frazee and Miss Joseph D. Frazee and a brother, Joseph Frazee.
